SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 11 1/2 x 22 in. (29 cm x 56 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® LET'S GET COZY: LAZY DAYS (Art. #141)
 #152 Pewter 2 balls
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

16 1/2 in. (42 cm) dowel

GAUGE

Five 3-dc groups = about 4 in. (10 cm) BE SURE TO CHECK GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. Hanging is worked back and forth in rows from the top downwards.
- 2. Fringe is attached to lower edge of Hanging, then top edge of Hanging is attached to a dowel.

HANGING

Beginning at top of hanging, ch 46.

Row 1: Work 3 dc in 5th ch from hook (4 skipped ch count as 1 base ch and beg dc), (sk next 2 ch, 3 dc in next ch) twice, ch 13, sk next 5 ch, 3 dc in next ch, (sk next 2 ch, 3 dc in next ch) 5 times, ch 13, sk next 5 ch, 3 dc in next ch, (sk next 2 chs, 3 dc in next ch) twice, sk next ch, dc in last ch – you will have twelve 3-dc groups, 2 ch-13 sps, and 1 dc at the beg and end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, dc in first dc, sk first 3-dc group, (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) twice, ch 6, sc in next ch-13 sp, ch 6, (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) 5 times, ch 6, sc in next ch-13 sp, ch 6, (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) twice, 2 dc in top of beg ch – Nine 3-dc groups, 4 ch-6 sps, 2 sc, and 2 dc at beg and end of row.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, 3 dc in sp between first 2-dc group and next 3-dc group, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) 4 times, ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, 3 dc in next sp between last 3-dc group and last 2-dc group, dc in top of beg ch – Eight 3-dc groups, 4 ch-6 sps, 6 sc, and 1 dc at beg and end of row.



Row 4: Ch 3, turn, dc in first dc, sk first 3-dc group, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next 3 sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) 3 times, ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next 3 sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, 2 dc in top of beg ch – Five 3-dc groups, 4 ch-6 sps, 10 sc, and 2 dc at beg and end of row.

Row 5: Ch 3, turn, 3 dc in sp between first 2-dc group and next 3-dc group, ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next 5 sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) twice, ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next 5 sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, 3 dc in next sp between last 3-dc group and last 2-dc group, dc in top of beg ch – Four 3-dc groups, 4 ch-6 sps, 14 sc, and 1 dc at beg and end of row.

Row 6: Ch 3, turn, dc in first dc, ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next 7 sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, ch 6, sc in next ch-6 sp, sc in next 7 sc, sc in next ch-6 sp, 2 dc in top of beg ch — One 3-dc group, 4 ch-6 sps, 18 sc, and 2 dc at beg and end of row.

Row 7: Ch 3, turn, 3 dc in first ch-6 sp, ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next 7 sc, ch 6, 3 dc in each of next 2 ch-6 sps, ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next 7 sc, ch 6, 3 dc in last ch-6 sp, dc in top of beg ch — Four 3-dc groups, 4 ch-6 sps, 14 sc, and 1 dc at beg and end of row.

Row 8: Ch 3, dc in first dc, 3 dc in first ch-6 sp, ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next 5 sc, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next 5 sc, ch 6, 3 dc in last ch-6 sp, 2 dc in top of beg ch — Five 3-dc groups, 4 ch-6 sps, 10 sc, and 2 dc at beg and end of row.

Row 9: Ch 3, turn, 3 dc in sp between first 2-dc group and next 3-dc group, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next 3 sc, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) twice, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next 3 sc, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, 3 dc in sp between last 3-dc group and last 2-dc group, dc in top of beg ch — Eight 3-dc groups, 4 ch-6 sps, 6 sc, and 1 dc at beg and end of row.

Row 10: Ch 3, turn, dc in first dc, sk first 3-dc group, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next sc, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) 3 times, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, sk next sc, sc in next sc, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, 2 dc in top of beg ch – Nine 3-dc groups, 4 ch-6 sps, 2 sc, and 2 dc at beg and end of row.

Row 11: Ch 3, turn, 3 dc in sp between first 2-dc group and next 3-dc group, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) 4 times, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, ch 6, 3 dc in next ch-6 sp, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, 3 dc in sp between last 3-dc group and last 2-dc group, dc in top of beg ch – Twelve 3-dc groups, 2 ch-6 sps, and 1 dc at beg and end of row.

Row 12: Ch 3, turn, dc in first dc, sk first 3-dc group, (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) twice, 6 dc in next ch-6 sp (6 dc counts as two 3-dc groups), (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) 5 times, 6 dc in next ch-6 sp (counts as two 3-dc groups), (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) twice, 2 dc in top of beg ch — Thirteen 3-dc groups, and 2 dc at beg and end of row.

Row 13: Ch 3, turn, 3 dc in sp between first 2-dc group and next 3-dc group, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups, 3 dc in sp between last 3-dc group and last 2-dc group, dc in top of beg ch — Fourteen 3-dc groups and 1 dc at beg and end of row.

Row 14: Ch 3, turn, dc in first dc, sk first 3-dc group, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups, 2 dc in top of beg ch – Thirteen 3-dc groups, and 2 dc at beg and end of row.

Rows 15 and 16: Rep Rows 13 and 14.

Row 17: Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 2 sts, sl st in next sp between first 2-dc group and next 3-dc group, ch 3, 2 dc in same sp between sts (beg ch-3 and following 2 dc count as first 3-dc group), 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups, 3 dc in sp between last 3-dc group and last 2-dc group; leave remaining sts unworked – Fourteen 3-dc groups.

NAXOS WALL HANGING

Pattern Number: M21282 LZ

Row 18: Ch 1, sl st in first 3 sts, sl st in next sp between 3-dc groups, ch 3, 2 dc in same sp between sts (beg ch-3 and following 2 dc count as first 3-dc group), 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups across — Thirteen 3-dc groups.

Rows 19-30: Rep Row 18 – you will have only one 3-dc group remaining in Row 30.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Fringe

For each fringe, cut 2 strands about 20 in. (51 cm) long. Hold strands together and fold in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of Hanging at one end of Row 30, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Make fringes in each end of all rows along lower diagonal edges of Hanging. Trim fringe ends at an angle.

Attaching Hanging to Dowel

Thread blunt needle with a long strand of yarn. Knot end of strand to the top edge of the Hanging.

Hold the dowel against the top edge of the Hanging. Loop the yarn over the dowel then draw through the top edge of the Hanging.

Continue in this way until the top edge of the Hanging is fully attached to the dowel.

Knot yarn.

Hanger

Thread blunt needle with a long strand of yarn in color as desired. Draw strand through one top corner of Hanging and knot. Draw remaining end of strand through opposite top corner of Hanging and knot.

If desired, trim yarn ends of the hanger.
