SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 16 in. (40.5 cm) diameter

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® FEELS LIKE BUTTA® THICK & QUICK® (Art. #155)
 #138 Woodrose 3 balls (A)
 #189 Vineyard Wine 3 balls (B)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size N (10 mm)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Fiberfill stuffing

GAUGE

Rnds 1-5 = about 5 1/2 in. (14 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

Puff (3-hdc puff – worked all in one st) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up a loop, (yarn over, insert hook in same st, yarn over and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over, draw through all 7 loops on hook, ch 1 to close puff.

Note: Closing ch-1 does not count as a separate st. It is part of the Puff.

NOTES

- 1. Pillow is made from 2 round Panels.
- 2. The second Panel is worked exactly like the first, but the yarn colors are reversed.
- 3. Yarn color is changed to make contrasting color Puff rnds. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color.
- 4. Panels are sewn together and stuffed to make the Pillow.



JANIS PILLOW Pattern Number: M22056 FLBTQ

PANELI

Wrap A around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Rnd 1 into the ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work 10 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – you will have 20 sc in this rnd.

Rnd 3: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 4: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 5: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around – 40 sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 7: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around – 50 sc.

Rnd 8: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around – 60 sc.

Rnd 9: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 10: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts; rep from * around – 70 sc.

Rnd 11: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts; rep from * around – 80 sc.

Rnd 12: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 13: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 7 sts; rep from * around – 90 sc.

Rnd 14: * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts; rep from * around and change to B in last st – 100 sc.

Do not cut A, drop it to the WS of work.

Rnd 15 (Puff Rnd): With B, * sc in next 4 sts, Puff in next st; rep from * around and change to A in last st – 80 sc and 20 Puffs.

Do not cut B, drop it to the WS of work.

Rnds 16 and 17: With A, sc in each st around and change to B in last st of Rnd 17 – 100 sc.

Rnd 18 (Puff Rnd): Rep Rnd 15, changing to A in last st.

Cut B.

Rnds 19 and 20: With A, sc in each st around.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

PANEL 2

Work same as Panel 1, reversing yarn colors.

FINISHING

Hold Panels with WS together and sts of last rnds matching. Using yarn tails still attached, sew Panels together, stuffing the Pillow before completing the seam.

Weave in ends.

WS = wrong side
