SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

Finished Width About 10 in. (25.5 cm) Finished Height About 14 1/2 in. (37 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND[®] FEELS LIKE BUTTA[®] THICK & QUICK[®] (Art. #155)
- #184 Peach Blush 3 balls (A)
- #133 Muted Clay 1 ball (B)
- LION BRAND[®] crochet hook size N (10 mm)
- LION BRAND[®] stitch markers
- LION BRAND[®] large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

9 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. Laptop Sleeve is worked in 2 pieces: Sleeve and Heart.
- 2. Sleeve is worked in continuous rnds (spiral) from the top edge downwards. Do not join last st of rnds to first st and do not turn at the beg of rnds.
- 3. Heart is worked separately in rnds.

LAPTOP SLEEVE

With A, leaving a long beg tail, ch 46 loosely.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 45 sc.

This strip of sc will be formed into a rnd at the beg of Rnd 2.

Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Taking care not to twist sts, curve the strip of sc so that last sc meets first sc of strip. Sc in first st of Rnd 1, sc in each remaining st around.

Rnd 3: Hdc in each st around.

Rep Rnd 3 until piece measures about 14 1/2 in. (37 cm) from beg.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

With yarn tail, sew edges of last rnd together for bottom of Sleeve.

With beg yarn tail, sew small bump at beg of Rnd 1 down.

HEART

Wrap B around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Rnd 1 into the ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2, (3 tr, 4 dc, tr, 4 dc, 3 tr, ch 2, sl st) in ring – at the end of Rnd 1 you will have 15 sts, 2 ch-2 sps and a sl st.

Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Rnd 2: Sc in next ch-2 sp, (2 hdc, dc) in next st, 3 dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, dc in next 4 sts, (dc, tr, dc) in next st, dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc in next st, 3 dc in next st, (dc, 2 hdc) in next st, sc in next ch-2 sp, sl st in next sl st – 29 sts and a sl st at end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: Sc in first 2 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) 3 times, sc in next 6 sts, (sc, hdc, sc) in next st, sc in next 6 sts, (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) 3 times, sc in next 2 sts; leave sl st unworked – 37 sts.

- 1. Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail.
- 2. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle, then draw through the last st made (as if fastening off).
- 3. Insert needle under top 2 loops of first st of rnd and draw through to WS.
- 4. Use yarn tail to sew Heart to one side of Sleeve.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
