## SKILL LEVEL – EASY

### SIZES

0-6 months (6-9 months, 12 months, 18 months)

**Finished Chest** About 20 (21 1/4, 22 3/4, 24) in. (51 (54, 58, 61) cm)

**Finished Length** About 8 1/2 (9 1/2, 10 1/2, 11 1/2) in. (21.5 (24, 26.5, 29) cm)

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

### MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® TOUCH OF LINEN (Art. #TK)  
#TK Light Blue 1 (2, 2, 2) ball(s)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size G-6 (4 mm)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



### GAUGE

17 dc = about 5 1/2 in. (14 cm); 9 rows = about 4 1/4 in. (11 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### NOTES

1. Cardigan is worked, back and forth in rows, from neck downwards.
2. Piece is divided at underarm to form armholes. Then body is worked down to lower edge. Sts are worked around each armhole to beg sleeves.

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## CARDIGAN

Beg at neck, ch 36.

**Row 1:** Dc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch do not count as a st) and in next 4 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 5 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 10 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next 5 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in last 5 ch – you will have 42 dc in this row.

Place a marker in center sc of each 3-sc group to indicate increase locations.

**Row 2 (Increase Row):** Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, \*dc in each st to next marker, 3 dc in marked st; rep from \* 3 more times, dc in each st to end of row – 50 dc.

Rep Row 2 for 8 (9, 10, 11) more times – 114 (122, 130, 138) dc in last increase row worked.

### *Divide for Body and Armholes*

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in each st to next marker, sk marked st and remove marker, sk all sts to next marker for first armhole, dc in marked st and remove marker, dc in each st to next marker, dc in marked st and remove marker, sk all sts to next marker for second armhole, sk marked st and remove marker, dc in each st to end of row – 62 (66, 70, 74) sts for body.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in each st across.

Rep Row 2 for 6 (7, 8, 9) more times.

Fasten off.

### *Sleeves*

From RS, join yarn with sl st in first skipped st of one armhole.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk same st as joining, dc in each of the rem skipped sts around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 26 (28, 30, 32) sts.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk same st as joining, dc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Rep Rnd 2 for 6 (7, 8, 10) more times.

Fasten off. Rep around rem armhole for second sleeve.

## FINISHING

### *Front Bands*

From RS join yarn with sl st in corner of front edge so that you are ready to work along edge between lower front corner and front neck corner.

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), work dc as evenly spaced as possible along front edge between lower and neck corners.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off. Rep along other front edge.

Weave in ends.

**beg** = begin(ning)

**ch** = chain

**dc** = double crochet

**rem** = remain(ing)

**rep** = repeat

**RS** = right side

**sc** = single crochet

**sl st** = slip stitch

**st(s)** = stitch(es)



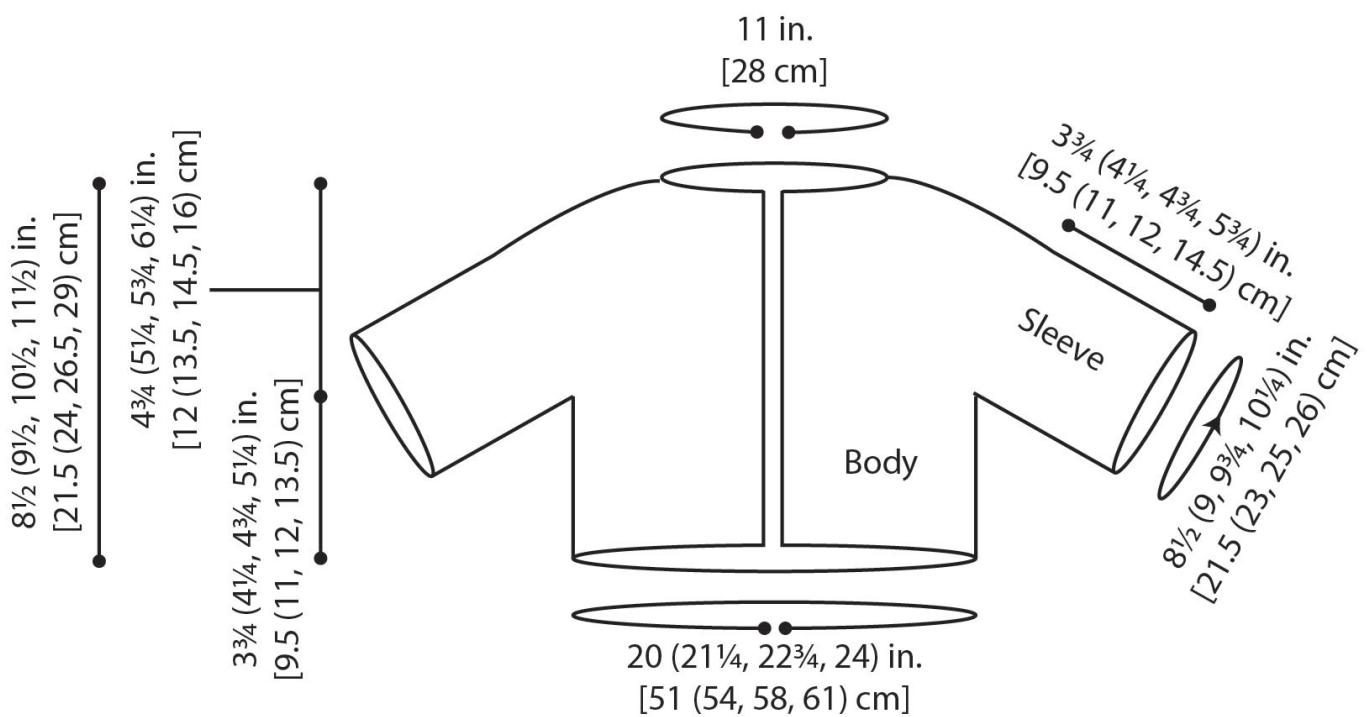
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
