## SKILL LEVEL – EASY

## SIZES

About 8 x 8 x 8 in. (20.5 x 20.5 x 20.5 cm), not including handles

## MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® FOR THE HOME CORDING (Art. #771)  
#100 Feather 4 balls
- LION BRAND® knitting needles size 6 (4 mm)
- LION BRAND® double pointed knitting needles size 6 (4 mm)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



## GAUGE

18 sts + 30 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern in Rows 1-4.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## NOTES

1. Bag is made from a “+” shape piece that is folded and seamed to make the Bag.
2. A Rectangle that forms the first 2 sides and bottom of Bag, is worked first. Sts are then picked up along side edges of the Rectangle for the remaining sides.
3. Piece is folded and edges of sides sewn tog to form the cube-shape Bag.
4. I-cord handles are worked directly onto top corners of Bag.

## RECTANGLE

### *First Side*

With straight needles, cast on 36 sts.

**Row 1 (WS):** Purl.

**Row 2:** K2, p2, \* k1, p2; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Row 3:** P2, k2, \* p1, k2; rep from \* to last 2 sts, p2.

**Row 4:** Knit.

**Rows 5-60:** Rep Rows 1-4 for 14 more times.

Place a marker on each end of last row worked.

### *Bottom*

**Rows 61-120:** Rep Rows 1-4 for 15 times.

Place a marker on each end of last row worked.

### *Second Side*

**Rows 121-180:** Rep Rows 1-4 for 15 times.

Bind off as if to purl.

### *Third Side*

From RS with straight needles, pick up and k36 sts evenly spaced along one side edge of Rectangle, between markers.

**Rows 1-60:** Rep Rows 1-4 of Rectangle for 15 times.

Bind off as if to purl.

### *Fourth Side*

Work same as third side, beg along opposite side of Rectangle.

## FINISHING

Fold up sides and sew edges together to make a cube-shape Bag.

### *I-Cord Handles*

From RS, working with 2 double pointed needles, pick up and k4 sts along top edge of Bag, centered above any corner. Do not turn work. \* Slide sts to other end of needle and knit them, pulling yarn tightly across the back of the work (do not turn work); rep from \* until handle measures about 18 in. (45.5 cm) long. Bind off.

Sew bound-off end to of handle to next corner.

In the same way, make a 2nd handle, attaching it to the remaining 2 corners.

Weave in ends.

**beg** = begin(ning)

**k** = knit

**p** = purl

**rep** = repeat

**RS** = right side

**st(s)** = stitch(es)

**tog** = together

**WS** = wrong side
