SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 6 x 9 in. (15 x 23 cm), measured flat and not including strap

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® FOR THE HOME CORDING (Art. #771)
#124 Willow 2 balls
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

18 sts + 11 rnds = about 5 in. (12.5 cm) over pattern in Rnds 7-10.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES

1. Bag is worked in one piece, in rnds from the lower edge upwards.
2. Base of Bag is worked in continuous rnds (spiral). Do not turn at the beg of rnds and do not join last st of rnd to first st.
3. Sides of Bag are then worked in joined and turned rnds. Turn at the beg of rnds and join last st of each rnd to first st with a sl st.
4. Strap, Button Loop, and Button are worked separately and sewn to Bag.
5. Each rnd of Sides begins with a ch-1. The ch-1 does not count as a stitch. Draw the ch-1 loop up to the height of sts to be worked in the rnd.

BAG

Base

Ch 19.

Rnd 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to last ch, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 16 ch, 2 sc in last ch (at base of first sc made); do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral) – you will have 38 sts in this rnd.

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in first st, sc in next 16 sts, 2 sc in each of next 3 sts, sc in next 16 sts, 2 sc in each of last 2 sts – 44 sts.

Rnds 3-5: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 6: Sc in each st around; join with sl st in first st to prepare to work sides in joined and turned rnds.

Remove marker.

Sides

Rnd 7 (RS): Ch 1, hdc in same st as joining sl st, ch 1, sk next st, * hdc in next st, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first hdc – 22 hdc and 22 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 8 (WS): Ch 1, turn, sc in each ch-1 sp and hdc around; join with sl st in first sc – 44 sts.

Rnd 9: Ch 1, turn, dc in each st around; join with sl st in first dc.

Rnd 10: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnds 11-22: Rep Rnds 7-10 for 3 more times.

Rnds 23 and 24: Rep Rnds 7 and 8.

Rnd 25: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

STRAP

Leaving a long yarn tail for sewing, ch 4.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 2 ch – 3 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Rep Row 2 until Strap measures about 48 in. (122 cm) from beg.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

Sew one end of Strap to top edge of Bag at side seam. Sew other end of Strap to opposite side of top edge.

BUTTON LOOP

Ch 15.

Row 1 (RS): Sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 14 sl sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Fold piece in half, bringing ends together. Sew ends of Button Loop to top edge of Bag at center back.

BUTTON

Ch 4; sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 8 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral) – 8 sts.

Place marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: (Sc2tog) 4 times – 4 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail through sts of last rnd and pull to close opening. Use remainder of tail to sew Button to center front of Bag, opposite Button Loop.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

ch-sp(s) = chain spaces previously made

rep = repeat

rnd(s) = round(s)

RS = right side

sc = single crochet

sk = skip

sl st = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
