SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZE

About 20 x 79 in. (51 x 201 cm), not including fringe

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® LB COLLECTION® COTTON BAMBOO (Art. #487)
#107 Hyacinth 6 balls
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

16 sts + 10 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm)
over alternating rows of sc and dc.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.



NOTES

1. Shawl is worked back and forth in alternating rows of single crochet (sc) and double crochet (dc).
2. To form the lacy diamond pattern, 2 chains are worked and 2 stitches are skipped in double crochet rows.
3. Detailed written instructions are provided for the first 12 rows. The remainder of Wrap is worked following Charts.

CHART NOTES

1. Odd-numbered rows are worked in single crochet (sc) and even-numbered rows are worked in double crochet (dc) and ch-2 sps.
2. A blue square represents a single crochet (sc) on odd-numbered rows and a double crochet (dc) on even-numbered rows. Each white square represents (ch 2, sk next 2 sts). It helps to use a highlighter to keep track of your rows!
3. To begin a dc row, ch 3, turn, and skip the first st (at the base of the ch-3). The beginning ch-3 counts as the first dc.
4. To begin an sc row, ch 2, turn and skip the first st. The beginning ch-2 counts as the first sc.
5. Work the last st of each row into the beg ch of the previous row.
6. Rows 1-74 are shown in Chart I. For Rows 75-122, repeat Rows 27-74. Rows 123-195 are shown in Chart II.

WRAP

Ch 79.

Row 1: Sc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as sc) and in each ch across – you will have 78 sc in this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next st, [ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 10 sts] 6 times, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next st, dc in beg ch-2 – 64 dc and 7 ch-2 sps.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as sc), turn, sk first st, sc in each dc and work 2 sc in each ch-2 sp across – 78 sc.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, (dc in next 4 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts) twice, dc in next 10 sts, (ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts) 5 times, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 10 sts, (ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts) twice, dc in beg ch-2 – 58 and 10 ch-2 sps.

Row 5: Ch 2 (counts as sc), turn, sk first st, sc in each dc and work 2 sc in each ch-2 sp across.

Row 6: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 7 sts, (ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 10 sts) 5 times, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 7 sts, dc in beg ch-2 – 66 and 6 ch-2 sps.

Row 7: Ch 2 (counts as sc), turn, sk first st, sc in each dc and work 2 sc in each ch-2 sp across.

Row 8: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 10 sts, (ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts) twice, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 10 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 10 sts, (ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts) twice, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 10 sts, dc in beg ch-2 – 62 dc and 8 ch-2 sps.

Row 9: Ch 2 (counts as sc), turn, sk first st, sc in each dc and work 2 sc in each ch-2 sp across.

Row 10: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 13 sts, (ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 10 sts) 4 times, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 13 sts, dc in beg ch-2 – 68 dc and 5 ch-2 sps.

Row 11: Ch 2 (counts as sc), turn, sk first st, sc in each dc and work 2 sc in each ch-2 sp across.

Row 12: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 10 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 10 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 16 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 10 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts, ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 10 sts, dc in beg ch-2 – 66 dc and 6 ch-2 sps.

Continue to alternate rows of single crochet and rows of double crochet and work ch-2 sps to form lacy diamond pattern following Charts, until all 195 rows of Charts have been completed.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Fringe

Cut 8 strands of yarn, each about 18 in. (45.5 cm) long. For each fringe, hold strands together and fold in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through first chain space along one short end of Wrap, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Make a fringe in each chain space along both short ends of Wrap.

Trim fringe evenly.

Weave in ends.

ch-sp(s) = chain space(s) previously made

dc = double crochet

rep = repeat

sc = single crochet

sk = skip



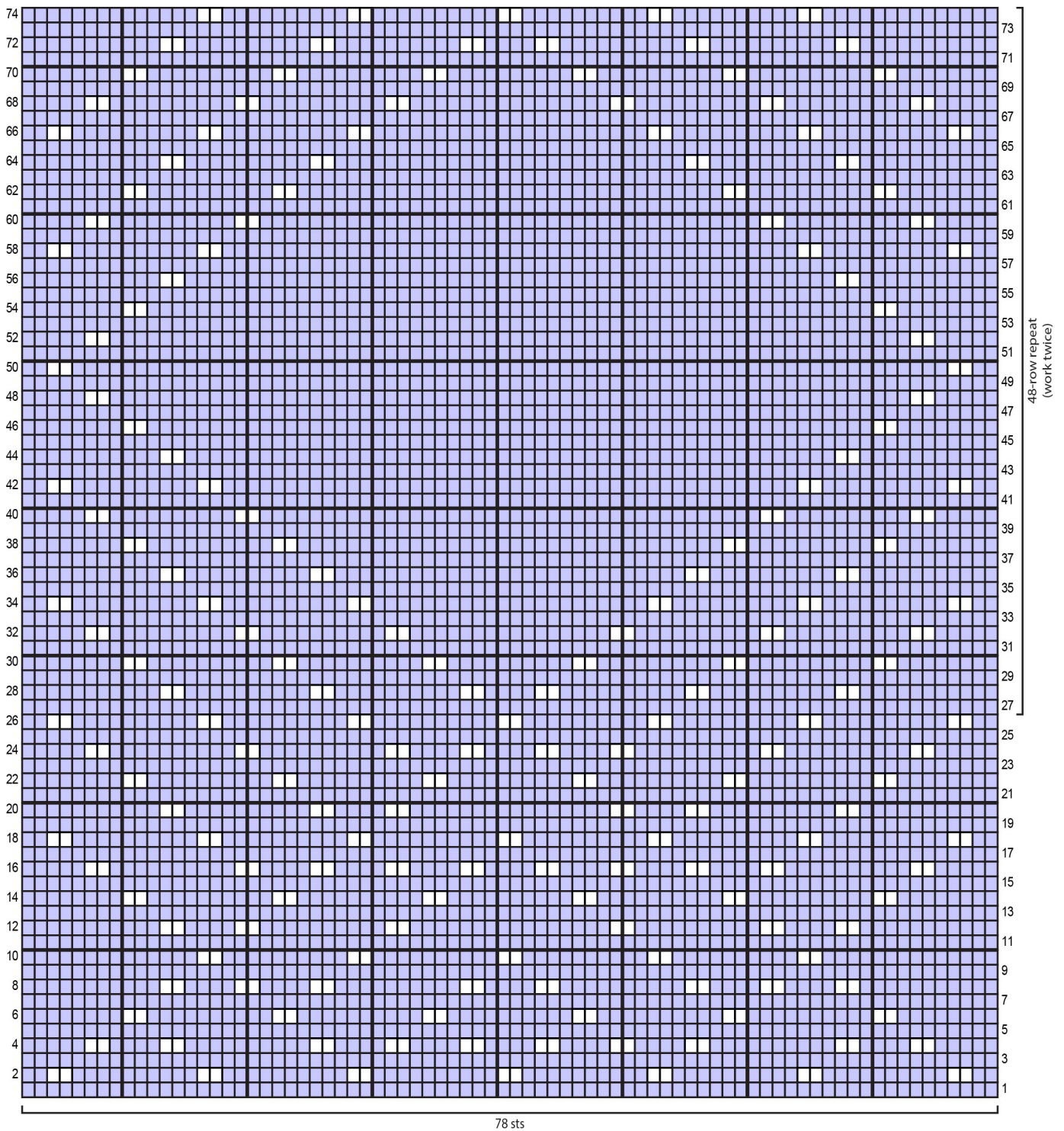

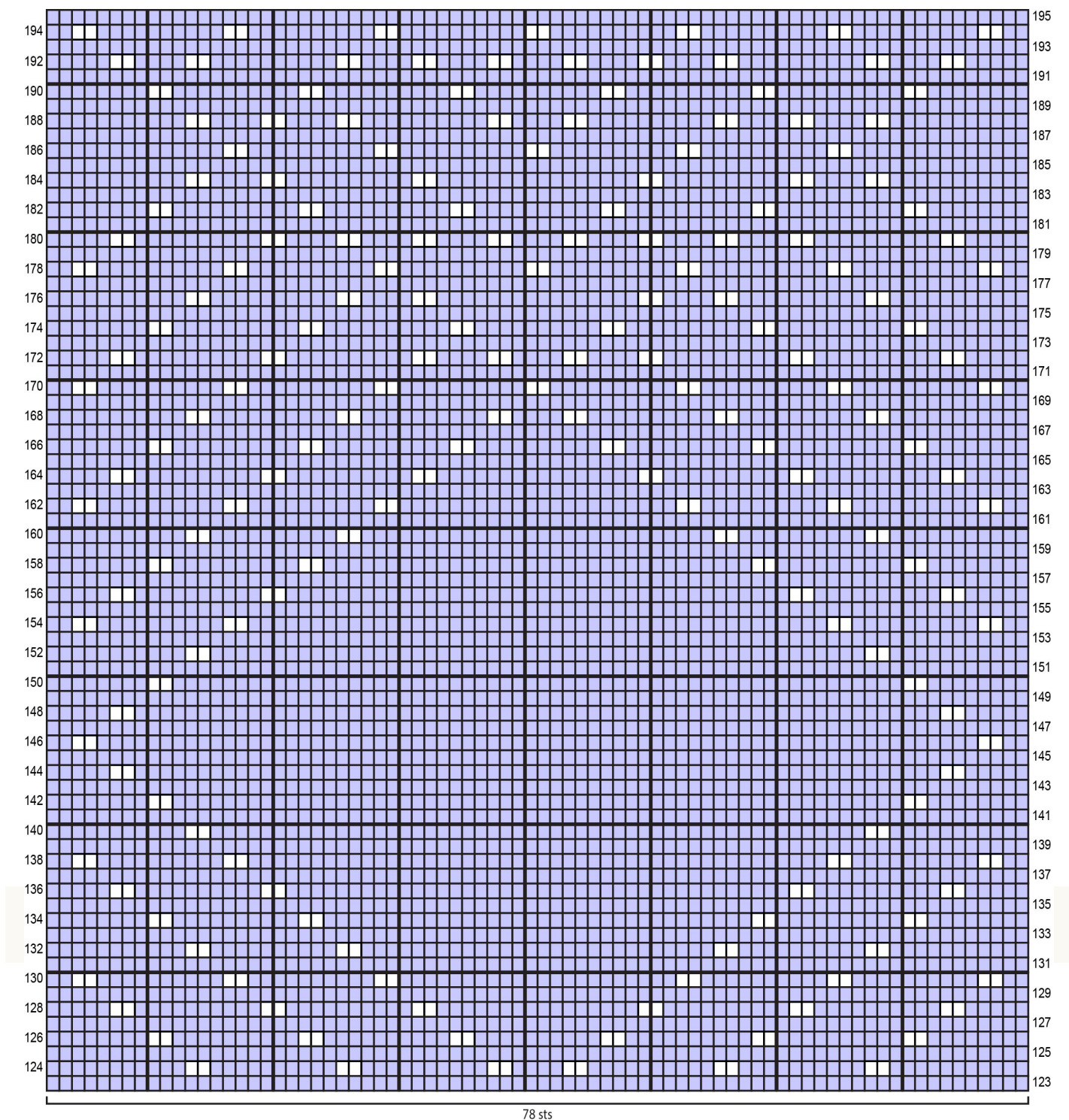
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
