# **SKILL LEVEL** – EASY

#### SIZE

**Finished Circumference** About 23 in. (58.5 cm), around head, not including brim **Finished Width** About 15 in. (38 cm), measured straight across at brim

### **MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND® REWIND (Art. #523)
  #159 Citronella 2 balls
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



#### **GAUGE**

14 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm) with larger hook.

Rnds 1-9 = about 6 in. (15 cm) across at widest.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

#### NOTES

- 1. Hat is worked in rnds from the top downwards.
- 2. Most of Hat is worked in continuous rnds (spiral) but a small section is worked in joined rnds. Read instructions carefully, taking care to work in continuous or joined rnds as instructed.
- 3. Hat brim is worked with a smaller hook to make it a bit firmer.

#### HAT

**Note:** Beg working Hat in continuous rnds (spiral). Do not join last st of rnds with sl st in first st. Do not turn at the beg of rnds.

With larger hook, wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Rnd 1.

Rnd 1 (RS): Work 8 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is worked.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each st to end of rnd – you will have 16 sc in this rnd.

Rnd 3: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from \* around – 24 sc.

Rnd 4: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* around – 32 sc.

- Rnd 5: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* around 40 sc.
- Rnd 6: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; rep from \* around 48 sc.
- Rnd 7: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts; rep from \* around 56 sc.
- Rnd 8: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts; rep from \* around 64 sc.
- Rnd 9: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 7 sts; rep from \* around 72 sc.
- Rnds 10-13: Sc in each st around.

**Note:** Rnds 14-16 are worked in joined rnds. Take care to join last st of each of these rnds with sl st in first st.

- **Rnd 14:** \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts; rep from \* around, remove end of rnd marker; join with sl st in first sc 80 sc.
- **Rnd 15:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), sk same st as joining sl st, sk next st, dc in next st, \* ch 1, sk next st, dc in next st; rep from \* to last st, ch 1, sk last st; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 40 dc and 40 ch-1 sps.
- Rnd 16: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), sk first ch-sp, dc in next dc, \* ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc; rep from \* to last ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk last ch-1 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-4.

#### **Brim**

**Note:** Work now resumes in continuous rnds (spiral). Do not join last st of rnds with sl st in first st.

Change to smaller hook.

Rnd 17: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), sk first ch-sp, dc in next dc, \* ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc; rep from \* to last ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk last ch-1 sp; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place marker in last ch-1 sp made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is worked.

- Rnd 18: Work 2 sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4, sc in beg ch-sp, (sc in next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp) 4 times, \* 2 sc in next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, (sc in next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp) 4 times; rep from \* around 88 sc.
- Rnd 19: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 10 sts; rep from \* around 96 sc.
- Rnd 20: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 7 sts; rep from \* around 108 sc.
- Rnd 21: Sc in each st around.
- Rnd 22: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts; rep from \* around 120 sc.
- Rnd 23: Sc in each st around.
- Rnd 24: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 9 sts; rep from \* around 132 sc.
- Rnd 25: Sc in each st around.
- Rnd 26: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 10 sts; rep from \* around 144 sc.
- Rnd 27: Sc in each st around.
- Rnd 28: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 11 sts; rep from \* around 156 sc.
- Rnd 29: Sc in each st around.
- Rnd 30: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 12 sts; rep from \* around 168 sc.
- Rnd 31: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 32: \* 2 sc in next st, sc in next 13 sts; rep from \* around – 180 sc.

Rnd 33: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

**RS** = right side

sc = single crochet
