## SKILL LEVEL – BEGINNER

### SIZE

**Finished length** About 14 in. (35.5 cm) long

### MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® MAC-RE-ME (Art. #845)
  - #098 Natural 1 ball (A)
  - #102 Sweet Pink 1 ball (B)
  - #127 Cinnabar 1 ball (C)

### NOTES

1. The yarn amounts will be sufficient to make multiple Rings.
2. Be sure to refer to the diagrams for the Ring and for the knots as you work!
3. Yarn color A is the flower petals, B is the flower center and both of these tie to yarn color C.

## FLOWER NAPKIN RING

### *Set Up*

Cut two 28 in. (71 cm) lengths each of yarns A, B and C.

1. Tie color A and color B strands together at one end with a simple overhand knot and secure to a flat surface (tape or a clip) with color A strands on the outside and B strands on the inside.

2. **First upper petal**

Using color C begin with a right hand square knot. Move the C strands, one behind and one on top of the B strands. Bring the left A strand from behind, go over both C strands and push through the loop. Repeat on the right side. Pull A strands downwards and pull C strands to the side. This creates the first upper petal.

3. **Second petal**

Change the placement of C and A strands.

From left to right, place A over C, go behind and through the loop. Pull tight. Place the A behind C, go in front and through the loop. Pull tight. Repeat to make the second petal. Using B strands bring the left strand on top and to the right, go behind and through the loop. Repeat again to finish the knot.

4. **Lower petal**

Using the same technique as above, create the lower petal to complete the first flower. Pull strands and adjust. Tie 2 square knots and repeat the full process until you have 3 flowers.



## FINISHING

Trim yarn C ends evenly to about 4 in. (10 cm) on each end.

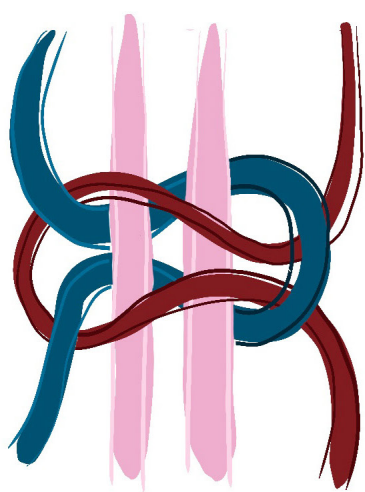
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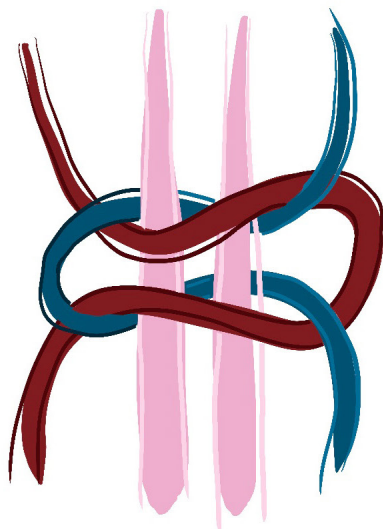
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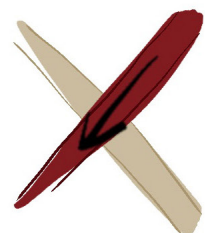
Right Hand Square Knot



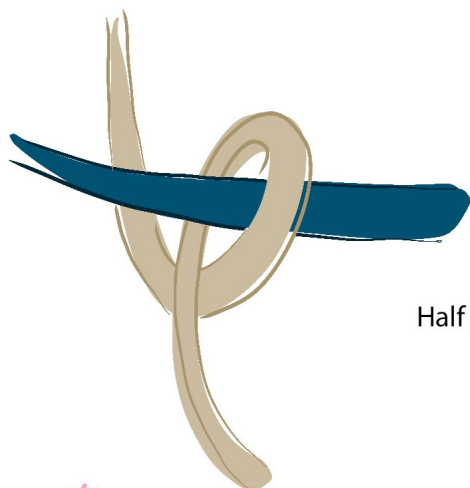
Left Hand Square Knot



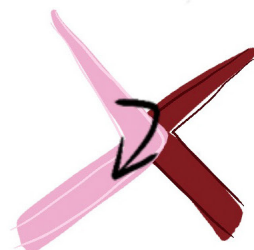
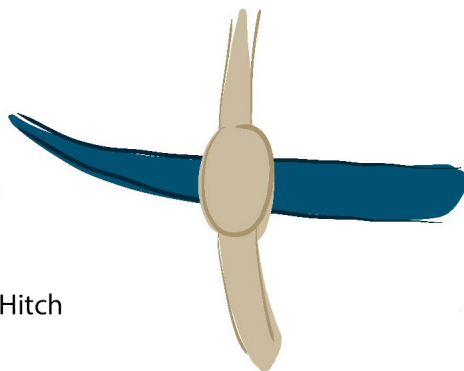
Forward Knot



Backward Knot



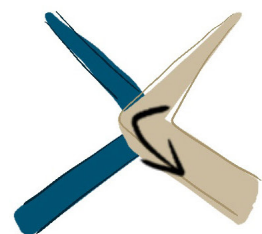
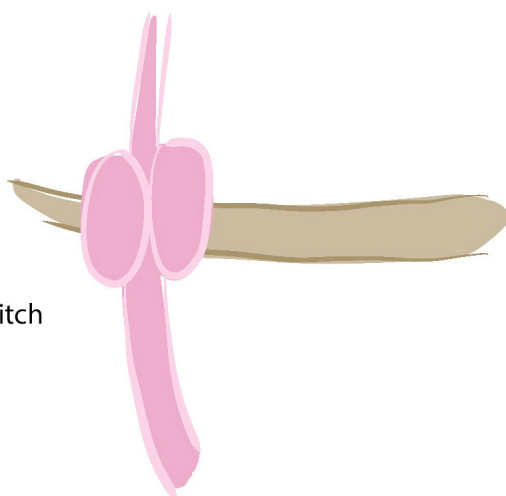
Half Hitch
