You will need a printer, paper, acrylic paints, paint brushes, a sharpie, a cup with water, and five smooth rocks.





BEFORE YOU BEGIN



After collecting your rocks, make sure to wash them clean with water to remove all of the dirt, before leaving them to dry.

Once the rocks are dry, set the table with pages of old newspapers, magazines or pieces of paper to ensure the table is protected from the paint.






Tip: Coat the rocks in a few layers of white paint first, so the colours will come out brighter!

SALTY THE POLAR BEAR




Start with a clean white rock.



Once dry, paint a white head shape.



Using a sharpie, add in the line details.



Paint the rock completely blue.




Then add the big blue nose, patch and ear pads!




To finish, splodge some white to create a snow effect!

CUDDLES THE PENGUIN




Start with a clean white rock.




With a dark grey, paint the head next.

Paint the grey body.




Time to add the cute footsies!




Using a sharpie, draw in the final lines!

ROSIE THE ROBIN




Start with a clean white rock.



Paint in the face using a sandy colour.



Add the blue beak and the grey patch.



Paint the rock completely brown.



Then paint in the red chest in soft brush strokes.



Grab a sharpie and draw in the final lines!

SNOWFLAKE PATTERNS


If there are any spare rocks, why not paint some snowflakes? Below are some examples you can follow!
