MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® NORTH POLE YARN CO: TINSEL (Art. #965)
 #965 Silver 1 ball (A)
- LION BRAND® NORTH POLE YARN CO: CANDY CAKE (Art. #967)
 #601 Green/White 1 ball (B)
 #600 Red/White 1 ball (C)
- LION BRAND® NORTH POLE YARN CO: SPARKLE (Art. #966)
 #098 Cream 1 ball (D)



Kraft paper wrapped gift boxes

Cardboard cut to size you'd like for your tassels or pom-pom

Natural (or craft store) elements – pinecones, greenery

Craft glue



GIFT WRAP

Such a fun and easy way to add an amazing DIY touch to your holiday gifts! Go with our ideas or branch out with yarn colors and embellishments that work with your style!

First, wrap yarn horizontally and then vertically to tie the kraft paper in place.

Wrap with as many strands of yarn as you like.

Then add embellishments – make yarn pom-poms or tassels and tie in place, or glue on natural elements that reflect the season.

Tassels

Wrap yarn around cardboard - the more wraps the fuller your tassel.

Cut 2 strands of yarn each about 10 in. (25.5 cm) long.

Draw one length under yarn strands at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard and remove cardboard.

Wrap the second length around all the strands slightly below top knot.

Knot this length securely.

Make tassels in 2 different lengths, then with the yarn ends from the top knot, tie the tassel to the wrapping yarn.

Pom-poms

Make pom-poms in the same way you made the tassel – but only use the top knot (don't make the second wrap around the strands).

After removing cardboard fluff pom-pom and trim into a ball shape.
