SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZE

One Size

Finished Bust About 44 in. (112 cm)

Finished Length About 16 1/2 in. (42 cm), not including lower edging

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® POUND OF LOVE® (Art. #550)
 - #132 Pumpkin Spice 1 ball (A)
 - #106 Pastel Blue 1 ball (B)
 - #122 Straw 1 ball (C)
 - #101 Pastel Pink 1 ball (D)
 - #172 Olive 1 ball (E)
 - #100 White 1 ball (F)
 - #145 Thistle 1 ball (G)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 8 (5 mm), 36 in. (90 cm) long or longer

MATERIALS NOTE

Only about 1/4 ball of each yarn color is needed to make Jacket.

GAUGE

19 sts = about 4 1/4 in. (11 cm); 30 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter Eyelet pattern.

1 Square = about 5 1/2 x 5 1/2 in. (14 x 14 cm)

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

M1 (make 1) An increase worked by lifting the horizontal strand lying between needles and placing it onto the left needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop – 1 st increased.

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

PATTERN STITCHES

Garter Eyelet Pattern (worked over a multiple of 2 sts)

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Rows 2 and 3: Knit.

Row 4 (WS): * Yo, p2tog; rep from * to end.

Rows 5 and 6: Knit.

Rep Rows 1-6 for Garter Eyelet pattern.

NOTES

1. Jacket is made from 28 separate pieces: 24 Squares for body and 4 Panels for Sleeves.
2. Squares and Panels are worked back and forth in rows of Garter Eyelet pattern, changing yarn color following Stripe Sequences.
3. Finished pieces are sewn together following a Diagram.
4. A circular needle is used to accommodate the sts for lower edging. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working on straight needles.
5. When you see work 'even' in the instructions, this means to continue on in the pattern st you have established without changing the st count by increasing, decreasing, or binding off.
6. When you see 'work in pattern as established' in the instructions, this means to work the next row of the pattern stitch, lining up sts as in previous rows.

JACKET

SQUARE I (make 12)

Stripe Sequence I

Work * 6 rows with D, 6 rows with E; rep from * for Stripe Sequence I.

With D, cast on 24 sts.

Row 1: Sl 1 (selvedge st), work Row 1 of Garter Eyelet pattern to last st, p1 (selvedge st).

Slipping first st and purling last st for selvedges, work even in Garter Eyelet pattern as established AND change yarn color following Stripe Sequence I for a total of 42 rows (7 stripes).

Bind off.

SQUARE II (make 12)

Stripe Sequence II

Work * 6 rows with A, 6 rows with B, 6 rows with C, 6 rows with D, 6 rows with E, 6 rows with F, 6 rows with G; rep from * for Stripe Sequence II.

Make same as Square I, casting on with A and changing yarn color following Stripe Sequence II.

SLEEVE PANEL I (make 2)

With D, cast on 76 sts.

Row 1: Sl 1 (selvedge st), work Row 1 of Garter Eyelet pattern to last st, p1 (selvedge st).

Slipping first st and purling last st for selvedges, work even in Garter Eyelet pattern as established AND change yarn color following Stripe Sequence I for a total of 36 rows (6 stripes).

Continue to change yarn color following Stripe Sequence I until piece is complete.

Shape Panel

Rows 1-5: Sl 1, work in Garter Eyelet pattern as established to last st, p1.

Row 6 (WS): Bind off 24 sts, work in Garter Eyelet pattern as established to last st, p1 – you will have 52 sts in this row.

Row 7: Sl 1, work in Garter Eyelet pattern as established to last st, p1.

Row 8 (WS): Bind off 6 sts, work in Garter Eyelet pattern as established to last st, p1 – 46 sts.

Rep Rows 7 and 8 until you have only 16 sts in last row worked.

Bind off.

SLEEVE PANEL II (make 2)

With A, cast on 24 sts.

Row 1: Sl 1 (selvedge st), work Row 1 of Garter Eyelet pattern to last st, p1 (selvedge st).

Slipping first st and purling last st for selvedges, work even in Garter Eyelet pattern as established AND change yarn color following Stripe Sequence II for a total of 42 rows (7 stripes).

Continue to change yarn color following Stripe Sequence II until piece is complete.

Shape Panel

Rows 1-4: Sl 1, work in Garter Eyelet pattern as established to last st, p1.

Row 5 (Increase Row – RS): Sl 1, work in Garter Eyelet pattern as established to last st, M1, p1 – you will have 25 sts in this row.

Rows 6-10: Sl 1, work in Garter Eyelet pattern as established to last st, p1.

Row 11: Rep Row 5 – 26 sts.

Rep Rows 6-11 until you have 34 sts in last row worked.

Slipping first st and purling last st for selvages, work even in Garter Eyelet pattern as established AND change yarn color following Stripe Sequence II until piece measures about 18 in. (45.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew Sleeve Panels together following Diagrams to make Sleeves.

With G, pick up and k46 sts evenly spaced along short edge of Sleeve, Do not knit any rows, immediately bind off.

Rep for 2nd Sleeve.

Following Diagrams, sew Squares together to make Back and Fronts.

Sew shoulder seams, beg at outer corners and sewing for about 7 in. (18 cm), leaving about 8 in. (20.5 cm) at center unsewn for neck.

Place markers on sides of Fronts and Back about 7 1/2 in. (19 cm) from shoulder seams. Sew Sleeves between markers.

Sew side and Sleeve seams.

Lower Edging

Note: We've not provided a specific number of sts to pick up for edging as this will vary between knitters.

We suggest working a swatch of the edging first as follows:

Pick up and knit sts along a 4 in. (10 cm) section of the lower edge of Jacket, then knit 4 rows. If you're happy with the look of the edging, use this as your gauge to pick up sts for the edging along the entire lower edge of Jacket. If the edging doesn't lay nicely, try picking up more or fewer sts along the section and knitting 4 rows.

From RS with E, pick up and knit sts evenly spaced along lower edge of Jacket.

Knit 4 rows.

Bind off.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = beginning

k = knit

p = purl

p2tog = purl 2 stitches together

rep = repeat

RS = right side

sl = slip

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side



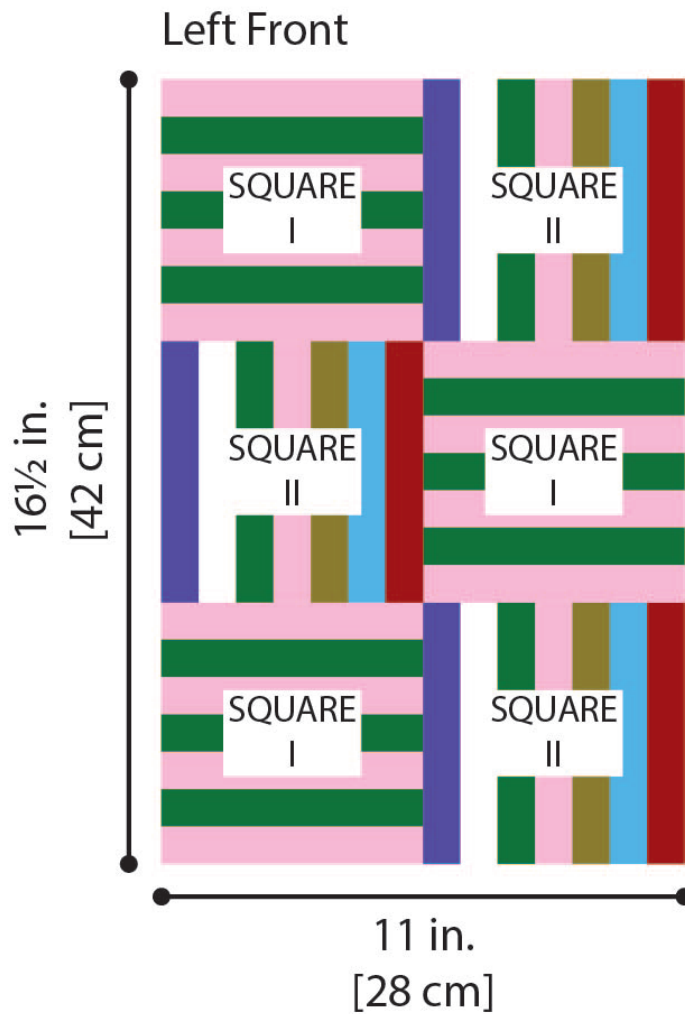

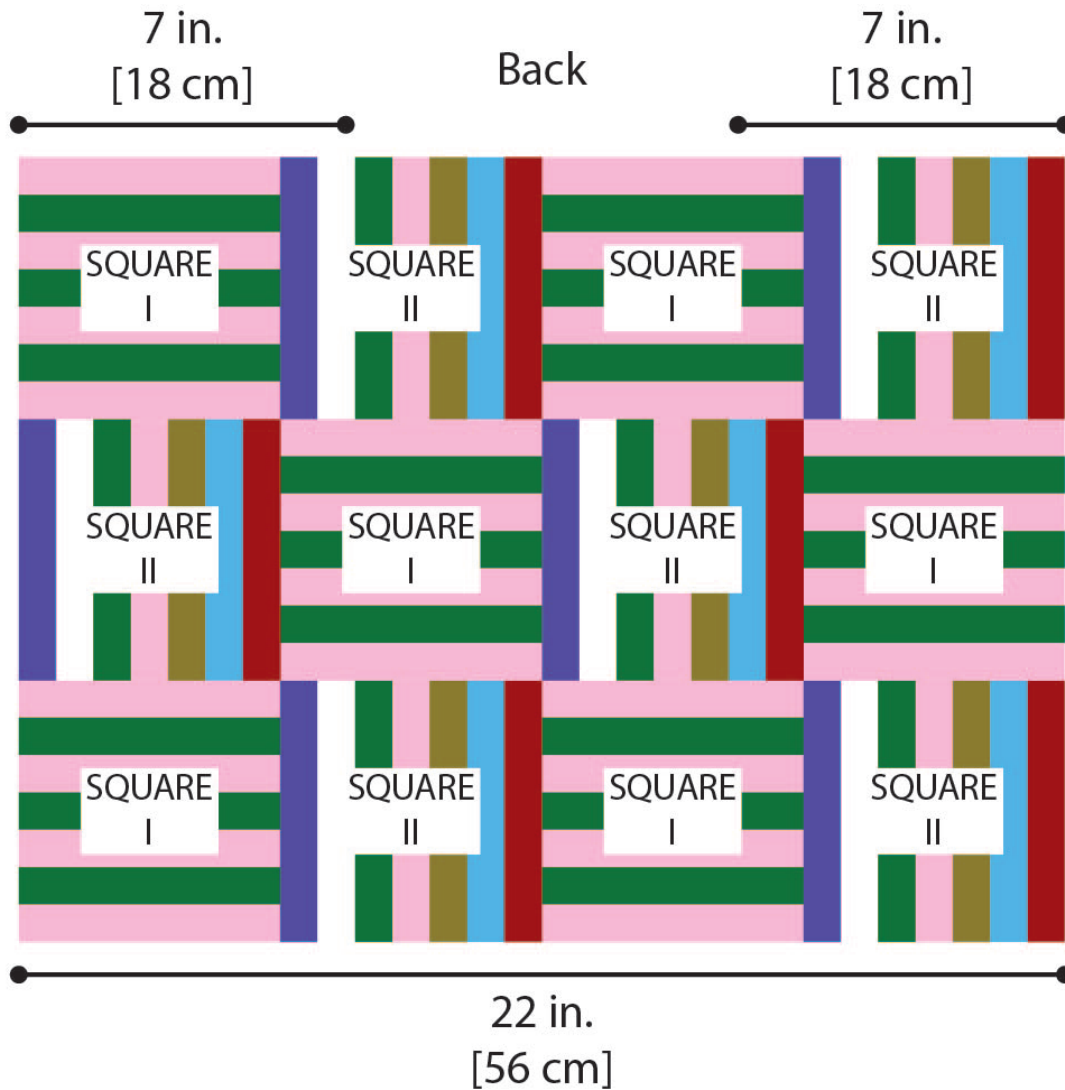
