## SKILL LEVEL – EASY

## SIZE

About 39 x 45 in. (99 x 114.5 cm)

## MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® POUND OF LOVE® (Art. #550)
  - #132 Pumpkin Spice 1 ball (A)
  - #101 Pastel Pink 1 ball (B)
  - #171 Fern 1 ball (C)
  - #156 Pastel Green 1 ball (D)
  - #122 Straw 1 ball (E)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



## GAUGE

Each pattern repeat = about 6 in. (15 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## NOTES

1. This project is worked in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
2. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Do not cut old color.

## AFGHAN

With A, ch 139.

**Row 1 (RS):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each of next 10 ch, 3 sc in next ch, \*1 sc in each of next 10 ch, skip next 2 ch, 1 sc in each of next 10 ch, 3 sc in next ch; rep from \* to last 11 ch, 1 sc in each of last 11 ch, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), \*skip 1 sc, 1 dc in each of next 10 sc, 3 dc in next sc, 1 dc in each of next 10 sc, skip 1 sc; rep from \* across, end 1 dc in last sc, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, skip next dc, 1 sc in each of next 10 dc, 3 sc in next dc, \*1 sc in each of next 10 dc, skip next 2 dc, 1 sc in each of next 10 dc, 3 sc in next dc; rep from \* across to last 11 dc, 1 sc in each of last 11 dc, turn.

With A, rep Rows 2 and 3 for 3 more rows, ending with Row 2.

Change to B.

Rep Rows 3 and 2 for 6 rows, ending with Row 2.

Change to C.

Rep Rows 3 and 2 for 6 rows, ending with Row 2.

Change to D.

Rep Rows 3 and 2 for 6 rows, ending with Row 2.

Change to E.

Rep Rows 3 and 2 for 6 rows, ending with Row 2.

Continue repeating Rows 3 and 2, working 6 rows each in A, B, C, D and E, 2 times more.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

**beg** = begin(ning)

**ch** = chain

**dc** = double crochet

**rep** = repeat

**RS** = right side

**sc** = single crochet

**st(s)** = stitch(es)

**WS** = wrong side
