# Camille The Bunny

## SKILL LEVEL – EASY

## SIZE

About 14 1/2 in. (37 cm) tall

## MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® POUND OF LOVE® (Art. #550)
  - #141 Quartz 1 ball (A)
  - #173 Waterfall 1 ball (B)
  - #150 Oxford Grey 1 ball (C)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size E-4 (3.5 mm)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

2 plastic safety eyes, 10mm diameter

6 pink buttons, 1/4-1/2 in. (6-13 mm) diameter

Fiberfill stuffing

White and black embroidery floss and embroidery needle (for eye details)

Sewing needle and thread (for sewing buttons to Dress)

## GAUGE

18 sc + 18 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm).

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT.

## STITCH EXPLANATION

**sc2tog (sc 2 sts together)** (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

## TECHNIQUE EXPLANATION

**Magic Ring:** Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the sts of Rnd 1 into the ring.

## NOTES

1. Camille is worked in 9 pieces: Head, Legs-Body, 2 Arms, 2 Ears, a Nose, a Tail, and Dress.
2. Head, Ears, Arms, and Tail are all worked in continuous rnds (spiral).
3. Legs-Body beg with 2 Legs worked separately in joined rnds. Legs are crocheted together. Body is then worked in continuous rnds (spiral) from top of Legs upwards.
4. Nose and Dress are worked back and forth in rows.
5. Pieces are sewn together to form Bunny, then small details are embroidered.
6. Exact gauge is not essential for this project. We worked tightly with a small hook so that stuffing wouldn't show through.

## SAFETY NOTE

If Bunny is intended for a baby or child, be certain that all pieces have been very securely sewn together. Don't leave a baby or child unattended with the Bunny!

## HEAD

With A, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each st around – you will have 12 sc in this rnd.

**Rnd 3:** \* Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 18 sc.

**Rnd 4:** \* Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 24 sc.

**Rnd 5:** \* Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 30 sc.

**Rnd 6:** \* Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 36 sc.

**Rnd 7:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 8:** \* Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 42 sc.

**Rnd 9:** \* Sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 48 sc.

**Rnds 10-13:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 14:** Sc in next 20 sts, 2 sc in each of next 28 sts – 76 sc.

**Rnd 15:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 16:** Sc in next 20 sts, (sc2tog, sc in next 12 sts) 4 times – 72 sc.

**Rnd 17:** Sc in next 20 sts, (sc2tog, sc in next 23 sts) twice, sc2tog – 69 sc.

**Rnd 18:** Sc in next 20 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 45 sts, sc2tog – 67 sc.

**Rnd 19:** Sc in next 20 sts, sc2tog, (sc in next 7 sts, sc2tog) 5 times – 61 sc.

**Rnd 20:** Sc in each st to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 60 sc.

**Rnd 21:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 22:** \* Sc in next 8 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 54 sc.

Attach safety eyes on front of Head between Rnds 11 and 12, on side where 28 increases were worked, and about 9 sts apart.

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**Rnd 23:** (Sc in next 7 sts, sc2tog) twice, (sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog) 6 times – 46 sc.

**Rnd 24:** Sc in each st around.

Begin stuffing piece and continue stuffing until piece is complete.

**Rnd 25:** Sc in next 16 sts, (sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog) 6 times – 40 sc.

**Rnd 26:** \* Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 32 sc.

**Rnd 27:** \* Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 24 sc.

**Rnd 28:** \* Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 18 sc.

Fasten off.

## LEGS-BODY

**Notes:** Legs are worked in joined rnds.

1. Join last st of each rnd to first st with a sl st.
2. Work first st of each rnd into the same (first) st as the joining sl st.
3. Do not turn at the beg of rnds.

### *First Leg*

With A, ch 8.

**Rnd 1:** Work 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 5 ch, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 5 ch; join with sl st in first sc – 16 sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in each of next 3 sts, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in each of next 3 sts, sc in last 5 sts; join with sl st in first sc – 22 sc.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) 3 times, sc in next 5 sts, (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) 3 times, sc in last 5 sts; join with sl st in first sc – 28 sc.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, (sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) 3 times, sc in next 5 sts, (sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) 3 times, sc in last 5 sts; join with sl st in first sc – 34 sc.

**Rnds 5-7:** Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 8:** Ch 1, sc in next 14 sts, (sc in next st, sc2tog) 6 times, sc in last 2 sts; join with sl st in first sc – 28 sc.

**Rnd 9:** Ch 1, sc in next 3 sts, (sc in next st, sc2tog) twice, sc in next 8 sts, (sc2tog) 4 times, sc in last 3 sts; join with sl st in first sc – 22 sc.

**Rnd 10:** Ch 1, sc in next 13 sts, (sc2tog) 4 times, sc in last st; join with sl st in first sc – 18 sc.

Begin stuffing piece and continue stuffing until piece is complete.

**Rnd 11:** Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next 8 sts, sc2tog, sc in last 6 sts; join with sl st in first sc – 16 sc.

**Rnds 12-21:** Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 22:** Ch 1, (sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice; join with sl st in first sc – 18 sc.

**Rnds 23 and 24:** Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 25:** Ch 1, (sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice; join with sl st in first sc – 20 sc.

**Rnd 26:** Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

## **Second Leg**

Make same as first leg but do NOT fasten off.

## **Join Legs**

**Rnd 27:** Continuing over sts of second leg, ch 1, sc in next 3 sts; leave rem sts unworked, ch 2 (for space between legs), insert hook in 14th st of last rnd of first leg and draw up a loop, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in rem 19 sts of first leg; working in back bumps only of chains between legs, sc in next 2 ch; working in sts of second leg, sc in first st following chain between legs, sc in next 16 sts, sk beg ch-1 (do not join with sl st), sc in next 3 sts; working in chains between legs, sc in next 2 ch; beg working in continuous rnds (spiral) for body – 44 sc.

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Do not fasten off.

## **Body**

**Rnds 28-34:** Sc in each st around.

Beg stuffing body and continue stuffing until piece is complete.

**Rnd 35:** (Sc in next 20 sts, sc2tog) twice – 42 sc.

**Rnds 36 and 37:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 38:** \* Sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 36 sc.

**Rnds 39-44:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 45:** \* Sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 30 sc.

**Rnds 46 and 47:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 48:** \* Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 24 sc.

**Rnds 49 and 50:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 51:** \* Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 18 sc.

**Rnds 52-54:** Sc in each st around.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing Body to Head.

## **EARS (make 2)**

With A, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each st around – you will have 12 sc in this rnd.

**Rnd 3:** (Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice – 14 sc.

**Rnd 4:** (Sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice – 16 sc.

**Rnd 5:** (Sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice – 18 sc.

**Rnd 6:** (Sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice – 20 sc.

**Rnd 7:** (Sc in next 9 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice – 22 sc.

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**Rnd 8:** (Sc in next 10 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice – 24 sc.

**Rnds 9-12:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 13:** \* Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 18 sc.

**Rnd 14:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 15:** \* Sc in next st, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 12 sc.

**Rnds 16-18:** Sc in each st around.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing Ear to Head.

## NOSE

With C, make a magic ring.

**Row 1:** Work 2 sc in ring; do not join, work back and forth in rows – 2 sc.

Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

**Row 2:** Turn, 2 sc in each of the 2 sts – 4 sc.

**Row 3:** Turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in last st – 6 sc.

Outer Edge: Ch 1, do NOT turn, working around outer edges of Nose, 2 sc in corner, sc in center of side edge, 3 sc in gap between the 2 sts of Row 1, sc in center of next side edge, 3 sc in next corner, sc in center 4 sts of Row 3, sc in next st; join with sl st in first sc – 15 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing Nose to Head.

## ARMS (make 2)

With A, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Work 8 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** \* Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 12 sc.

**Rnd 3:** \* Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 16 sc.

**Rnds 4-6:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 7:** \* Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 12 sc.

**Rnd 8:** \* Sc in next st, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 8 sc.

**Rnds 9-23:** Sc in each st around.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing Arms to Body.

Stuff Arm lightly.

## TAIL

With C, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** Work 2 sc in each st around – 12 sc.

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**Rnd 3:** \* Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 16 sc.

**Rnd 4:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 5:** \* Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 12 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing Tail to Body.

Stuff Tail.

## DRESS

With B, ch 36.

**Row 1:** Dc in 7th ch from hook (6 skipped ch form button loop), dc in next 3 ch, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch, dc in next 5 ch, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch, dc in next 8 ch, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch, dc in next 5 ch, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch, dc in last 4 ch – 34 dc and 4 ch-2 sps.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in first 5 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 7 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 10 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 7 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-2 sp, dc in last 5 sts – 42 dc and 4 ch-2 sps.

**Row 3:** Ch 5 (for button loop), turn, dc in first 6 sts, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk next 9 sts (for armhole), 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 12 sts, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sk next 9 sts (for armhole), 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in last 6 sts – 32 dc and 2 ch-2 armhole sps.

**Row 4:** Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, working in each dc and each ch, \* dc in next st, 2 dc in next st; rep from \* across – 54 dc.

**Row 5:** Ch 5 (for button loop), turn, dc in first 8 sts, 2 dc in next st, \* dc in next 8 sts, 2 dc in next st; rep from \* across – 60 dc.

**Row 6:** Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in each st across.

**Row 7:** Ch 5 (for button loop), turn, dc in each st across.

**Rows 8-11:** Rep Rows 6 and 7 for 2 more times.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Using photograph as a guide and yarn tails still attached to pieces whenever possible, assemble Camille as follows:

With A, sew Body to Head.

With C, sew Nose to Head, between Rnds 12 and 18.

With C, embroider mouth line between Rnds 17 and 23.

With C, embroider eyebrows on face between Rnds 6 and 10, about 7 sts apart.

With white embroidery floss, embroider curves along outer edges of safety eyes for whites of eyes.

With black embroidery floss, embroider curves along upper outer edges of safety eyes.

With A, sew an Ear to each side of Head, between Rnds 3 and 9.

With A, sew an Arm to each side of Body, between Rnds 48 and 49.

With C, sew Tail to back of Body, between Rnds 33 and 37.

With sewing needle and thread, sew buttons to Dress, opposite button loops.

Weave in ends.
