Kitty Loveseat

FREE CROCHET PATTERN

M23000 BSAMTQ

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SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZE

Finished Height About 6 1/2 in. (16.5 cm)

Finished Length About 16 in. (40.5 cm)

Finished Deep About 10 in. (25.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® BASIC STITCH ANTI-MICROBIAL THICK & QUICK® (Art. #209)
 - #106 Bluestone 1 ball (A)
 - #144 Lavender Mist 1 ball (B)
 - #147 Lilac 1 ball (C)
 - #152 Charcoal 1 ball (D)
 - #149 Cement 1 ball (E)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size N-13 (9 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Fiberfill stuffing

1 in. (2.5 cm) thick craft foam, 2 sheets of 24 x 24 in. (61 x 61 cm)

Craft glue

MATERIALS NOTE

You may find it easiest to sew Loveseat pieces together with a sewing needle and thread. In this case add the needle and thread to your shopping list!

GAUGE

10 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Griddle Stitch pattern, unstretched.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

PATTERN STITCH

Griddle Stitch (worked over an even number of sts; +1 additional foundation ch)

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch, * sc in next ch, dc in next ch; rep from * across.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, * sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from * across.

Rep Row 2, working sc in each dc and dc in each sc, for Griddle Stitch pattern.

NOTES

1. Loveseat is made from 12 pieces: Base, 2 Sides, Seat, Backrest, 2 Backrest Ends, 2 Arms, 2 Arm Ends, and a Ruffle.
2. Pieces are worked separately then sewn together and stuffed.

SEAT

Base

With D, ch 35.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Griddle Stitch pattern until piece measures about 7 1/4 in. (18.5 cm) from beg – you will have 34 sts in each row.

Fasten off.

SIDES (make 2 – 1 each with A and B)

Ch 19.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Griddle Stitch pattern until piece measures about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm) from beg – 18 sts in each row.

Fasten off.

SEAT

With C, ch 35.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Griddle Stitch pattern until piece measures about 14 1/4 in. (36 cm) from beg – 34 sts in each row.

Fasten off.

BACKREST

With E, ch 35.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Griddle Stitch pattern until piece measures about 9 1/2 in. (22 cm) from beg – 34 sts in each row.

Fasten off.

BACKREST ENDS (make 2)

With B, ch 5.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Griddle Stitch pattern for 6 rows – 4 sts in each row.

Next row (Decrease Row): Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next dc, dc in last sc – 3 sts.

Fasten off.

ARMS (make 2)

With D, ch 15.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Griddle Stitch pattern until piece measures about 6 in. (15 cm) from beg – 14 sts in each row.

Fasten off.

ARM ENDS (make 2)

With B, ch 3.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Griddle Stitch pattern for 3 rows – 2 sts in each row.

Next row (Decrease Row): Ch 1, turn, sc2tog – 1 st.

Fasten off.

RUFFLE

With D, ch 33.

Row 1: Dc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 dc in next ch, * dc in next ch, 2 dc in each of next 2 ch; rep from * across – 53 dc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Assembly

Note: We've provided some suggested measurements for the foam pieces – but please let the size of your crochet pieces guide you! We advise cutting the foam a little larger than the crochet pieces, then stretching the crochet snugly over the foam.

Refer to the diagrams as you assemble.

1. Cut 3 pieces of foam, each about 9 1/2 x 15 1/2 in. (24 x 39.5 cm). Glue the 3 pieces together. Wrap the crochet Seat over the foam, then sew the Sides to the edges of the Seat. If needed, add stuffing around foam to fill out the shape.
2. Sew Base to edges of Seat and Sides.
3. Sew Backrest Ends to Backrest.

4. Cut a piece of foam, about 4 x 15 1/2 in. (10 x 39.5 cm), and insert into Backrest. Add stuffing around foam to fill out the shape.
5. Sew Arm Ends to Arms.
6. Cut 2 pieces of foam, each about 2 1/2 x 6 1/2 in. (6.5 x 16.5 cm), and insert into Arms. Add stuffing around foam to fill out the shape.
7. Sew open side of Backrest to Seat, then sew open sides of Arms to Seat.
8. Sew Ruffle to front of Loveseat.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

ch = chain

dc = single crochet

rep = repeat

sc = single crochet

st(s) = stitch(es)

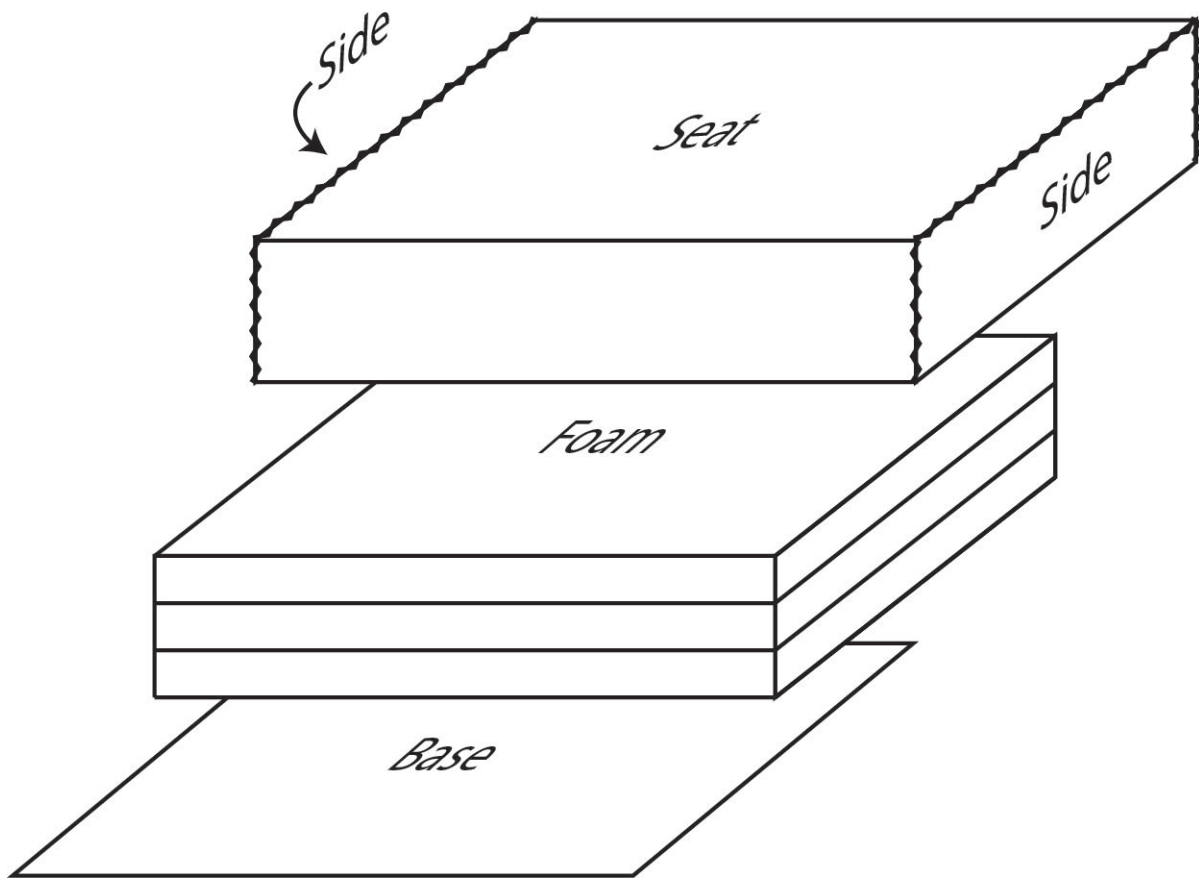
