Finished Chest About 46 in. (117 cm), including edging and trim
Finished Length About 28 in. (71 cm), including trim

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® JIFFY BONUS BUNDLE (Art. #451)
 #098 Cream 1 ball (A)
 #105 Aero 1 ball (B)
 #109 Coastal 1 ball (C)
 #110 Deep Indigo 1 ball (D)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

1 Granny Square = about 4 x 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. Jacket is made from 71 Granny Squares and 62 Triangles.
- 2. 31 Squares and 18 Triangles are used for Back, 13 Squares and 12 Triangles for each Front, and 7 Squares and 10 Triangles for each Sleeve.
- 3. Squares are worked in joined rnds. Triangles are worked back and forth in rows.
- 4. To shape Back, Fronts, and Sleeves, an edging is worked along side edges. Edging is also worked along wrist edge of Sleeves for cuffs.
- 5. Pieces are sewn together following a Diagram, then rnds of trim are worked around outer edges.
- 6. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Do not fasten off old color until instructed, drop old color to WS of work and carefully carry it up when it is needed in the next rnd.

SINGLE COLOR SQUARES (make 31 – 7 with A, 9 with B, 6 with C, and 9 with D)

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – you will have 12 dc and 4 ch-2 sps in this rnd (3 dc along each of 4 sides between ch-2 sps).

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk same st as joining sl st, dc in next 2 sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp (corner made), * dc in next 3 sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from * 2 more times; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 28 dc and 4 corner ch-2 sps (7 dc along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Rnd 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk same st as joining sl st, dc in next 4 sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, * dc in next 7 sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from * 2 more times, dc in last 2 sts; join with st st in top of beg ch-3 – 44 dc and 4 corner ch-2 sps (11 dc along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Fasten off.

TWO-COLOR GRANNY SQUARES (make 40 – in indicated yarn color combinations)

Combination #1 (make 10): A, B.

Combination #2 (make 12): B, C.

Combination #3 (make 8): C, D.

Combination #4: (make 10): D, A.

With first color, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): With first color, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 2 times; with B, ch 2, 3 dc in ring, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 12 dc and 4 ch-2 sps in this rnd (9 dc and 2 ch-2 sps with A, and 3 dc and 2 ch-2 sps with B).

Rnd 2: With B, ch 3 (counts as dc), sk same st as joining sl st, dc in next 2 sts, * (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 sts; rep from * once more, 2 dc in next corner ch-2 sp; with A, ch 2, 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 28 dc and 4 corner ch-2 sps (9 dc and 2 ch-2 sps with A, and 19 dc and 2 ch-2 sps with B).

Rnd 3: With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), sk same st as joining sl st, dc in next 4 sts, * (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, dc in next 7 sts; rep from * once more, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp; with B, ch 2, 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, dc in next 7 sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp, dc in last 2 sts; join with st st in top of beg ch-3 – 44 dc and 4 corner ch-2 sps (29 dc and 2 ch-2 sps with A, and 15 dc and 2 ch-2 sps with B).

Fasten off.

TRIANGLES (make 62 – 19 with A, 14 with B, 16 with C, and 13 with D)

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ring; do not join, work back and forth in rows – 6 dc and 1 ch-2 sp (3 dc on each side of center ch-1 sp).

Row 2 (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first st, dc in next 2 sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in center ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 sts, 3 dc in top of beg ch-3 – 14 dc and 1 ch-2 sp (7 dc on each side of center ch-1 sp).

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first st, dc in next 6 sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in center ch-2 sp, dc in next 6 sts, 3 dc in top of beg ch-3 – 22 dc and 1 ch-2 sp (11 dc on each side of center ch-1 sp).

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Following Diagram, sew Squares and Triangles together to make Back, Fronts, and Sleeves.

Place markers on side edges of Back and Fronts, in center ring of 2nd Triangle below top edge.

Right Side of Back Edging

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join B with sc in lower corner of right edge of Back, (work 15 sc evenly spaced along edge of next Triangle, sc in join between Triangles) 3 times, work 7 sc evenly spaced along edge of next Triangle to marker, sc in center ring of Triangle – 57 dc.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across.

Fasten off.

Left Side of Back Edging

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join B with sc in marked center ring of left edge of Back, work 7 sc evenly spaced along edge of Triangle, (sc in join between Triangles, work 15 sc evenly spaced along edge of next Triangle) 3 times, sc in lower corner – 57 dc.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across.

Fasten off.

Left Side of Front Edging

Work same as Right Side of Back Edging.

Rep Edging on 2nd Front.

Right Side of Front Edging

Work same as Left Side of Back Edging.

Rep Edging on 2nd Front.

Remove markers.

Right Side of Sleeve Edging

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join C with sc in lower corner of right edge of one Sleeve, (work 15 sc evenly spaced along edge of next Triangle, sc in join between Triangles) twice, work 15 sc evenly spaced along edge of next Triangle, sc in top corner – 49 sc.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 19 sts, hdc in next 20 sts, sc in next 9 sts.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 15 sts, hdc in next 10 sts, dc in next 24 sts working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 14 sts, hdc in next 10 sts, sc in next 5 sts; leave rem 19 sts unworked – 30 sts.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 5 sts, sc in next 5 sts, hdc in next 8 sts, dc in last 12 sts.

Fasten off.

Left Side of Sleeve Edging

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join C with sc in lower corner of left edge of Sleeve, (work 15 sc evenly spaced along edge of next Triangle, sc in join between Triangles) twice, work 15 sc evenly spaced along edge of next Triangle, sc in top corner – 49 sc.

Row 2 (WS): Ch 1, turn, sc in first 9 sts, hdc in next 20 sts, dc in last 20 sts.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 23 sts, hdc in next 10 sts, sc in last 15 sts.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 19 sts, sc in next 5 sts, hdc in next 10 sts, dc in last 14 sts working last dc in top of beg ch-3 – 30 sts.

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next 11 sts, hdc in next 8 sts, sc in next 5 sts; leave rem sts unworked – 25 sts.

Fasten off.

Rep Sleeve Edgings on 2nd Sleeve.

Cuff

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join B with sc in lower corner of side edging so that you are ready to work across lower (narrower) edge of Sleeve, work 3 more sc evenly spaced along edge of side edging, work 15 sc evenly spaced along edge of next Triangle, sc in join between Triangles, work 15 sc evenly spaced along edge of next Triangle, work 3 sc evenly spaced along edge of side edging – 38 sc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc) turn, sk first st, dc in each st across.

Rows 3 and 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across working last st in top of beg ch-3.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sl st in each st across.

Fasten off.

Sew shoulder seams for about 6 1/2 in. (16.5 cm), leaving about 9 in. (23 cm) unsewn at center for back neck. Sew tops of Sleeves into armholes.

Place markers on side edges of Back and Fronts, in line with center of 2nd Triangle above lower edge.

Sew Sleeve and side seams, leaving edges below markers on Back and Fronts unsewn for side slits.

Body Trim

Rnd 1 (RS): From RS, join B with sc in one lower corner of right side slit, sc evenly spaced all the way around outer edge, working 3 sc in each corner.

Rnd 2: SI st in each st around; join with sI st in first sI st.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
