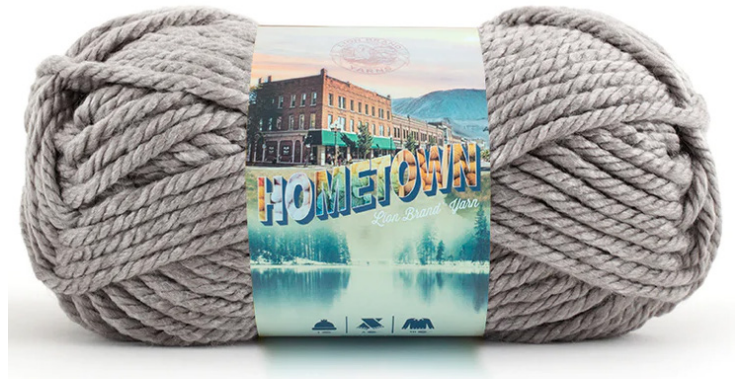
SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 6 x 75 in. (15 x 190.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® HOMETOWN® (Art. #135)
#149 Dallas Grey 4 balls (A)
#100 New York White 1 ball (B)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 13 (9 mm), 40 in. (100 cm) long or longer

GAUGE

8 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over St st (k on RS, p on WS).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Scarf is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows of St st (k on RS, p on WS), changing yarn color to form stripes.
2. Piece is folded and seamed to make a cozy double thick Scarf.
3. A circular needle is used to accommodate the sts. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working with straight needles.

SCARF

With A, cast on 150 sts.

Beginning with a RS (knit) row, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) for 28 rows.

With B, continue in St st for 3 rows.

With A, work in St st for 3 rows.

With B, work in St st for 3 rows.

With A, continue in St st until piece measures about 12 in. (30.5 cm) from beginning.

Bind off loosely.

FINISHING

From RS, fold Scarf in half lengthwise, bringing cast-on edge to meet bound-off edge and creating a doubled Scarf.

Seam the double layers of Scarf together around 3 sides as follows:

First seam edges along one short end, then edges along long side of Scarf, then edges of remaining short end.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

p = purl

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

St st = Stockinette stitch

WS = wrong side



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
