SIZES

S (M, L 1X) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X)

Finished Chest About 34 (38, 42, 46) (50, 54, 58, 62) in. (86.5 (96.5, 106.5, 117) (127, 137, 147.5, 157.5) cm) **Finished Length** About 19 1/2 (20, 20 1/2, 21) (21 1/2, 22, 22 1/2, 23) in. (49.5 (51, 52, 53.5) (54.5, 56, 57, 58.5) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

LION BRAND[®] BASIC STITCH[®] ANTI-PILLING (Art. #202) #404 Silver Heather 4 (4, 4, 5) (5, 6, 7, 7) balls (A) #100 White 2 (2, 2, 2) (3, 3, 3, 3) balls (B) #106 Baby Blue 1 (1, 1, 1) (1, 1, 1, 1) ball (C) #153 Black 1 (1, 1, 1) (1, 1, 1, 1) ball (D) #133 Pumpkin 1 (1, 1, 1) (1, 1, 1, 1) ball (E)

- LION BRAND[®] stitch markers
- LION BRAND[®] stitch holders
- LION BRAND[®] large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular needle size 8 (5 mm), 16 in. (40 cm) long Circular needle size 8 (5 mm), 29 in. (73.5 cm) long or longer

GAUGE

18 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm); 28 rows = about 5 in. (12.5 cm) over St st (k on RS, p on WS). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.



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STITCH EXPLANATIONS

M1 (make 1) An increase worked by lifting the horizontal strand lying between needles and placing it onto the left needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop – 1 st increased.

sk2p (slip 1, k2tog, pass over) Slip 1 as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over – 2 sts decreased.

sp2p (slip, p2tog, pass over) Slip 1 as if to purl, purl 2 together, pass slipped stitch over – 2 sts decreased.

NOTES

- 1. Pullover is made in 4 pieces: Back, Front, and 2 Sleeves.
- 2. Pieces are worked separately, back and forth in rows, from lower ribbing upwards.
- 3. Snowperson pattern on Front is worked in intarsia colorwork following a Chart. Bobble for Snowperson's hat is worked separately and sewn to Front.
- 4. When working intarsia, do not carry yarn across WS of work between color changes, use a separate ball of yarn for each section of color. When changing color, twist yarns on WS to prevent holes.
- 5. Arms of Snowperson are embroidered in stem stitch. Snowflakes, eyes, mouth, buttons, and carrot are worked in duplicate st.
- 6. Yarn color is changed following Sleeve Stripe Sequence to make stripes on Sleeves. Do not cut yarn colors until instructed. Carry color not in use carefully up side of piece.
- 7. A circular needle is used to accommodate the stitches. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working with straight needles.
- 8. When you see work 'even' in the instructions, this means to continue on in the pattern st you have established without changing the st count by increasing, decreasing, or binding off.

ВАСК

With longer circular needle and A, cast on 77 (85, 95, 103) (113, 121, 131, 139) sts.

Row 1: K1, * p1, k1; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) from beg.

Work even in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures about 17 1/2 (18, 18 1/2, 19) (19 1/2, 20, 20 1/2, 21) in. (44.5 (45.5, 47, 48.5) (49.5, 51, 52, 53.5) cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Shape Shoulders

Next 8 rows: Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4) (5, 5, 6, 6) sts, work in St st to end of row – you will have 53 (61, 63, 71) (73, 81, 83, 91) sts when all bind offs have been completed.

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Shape Neck and Continue to Shape Shoulders

Shape Right Shoulder

Row 1 (RS): Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4) (4, 5, 5, 6) sts, k9 (12, 12, 15) (15, 18, 18, 21) for right shoulder, place next 31 (31, 33, 33) (35, 35, 37, 37) sts on a holder for back neck, then place rem 11 (15, 15, 19) (19, 23, 23, 27) sts on a holder for left shoulder – 9 (12, 12, 15) (15, 18, 18, 21) sts.

Work on right shoulder sts only.

Row 2: Bind off 2 sts, p to end of row – 7 (10, 10, 13) (13, 16, 16, 19) sts.

Row 3: Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4) (4, 5, 5, 6) sts, k to end of row – 5 (7, 7, 9) (9, 11, 11, 13) sts.

Row 4: Bind off 1 st, p to end of row – 4 (6, 6, 8) (8, 10, 10, 12) sts.

Bind off.

Shape Left Shoulder

Return left shoulder sts to needle so that you are ready to work a RS row.

Row 1 (RS): Bind off 2 sts, k to end of row – 9 (13, 13, 17) (17, 21, 21, 25) sts.

Row 2: Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4) (4, 5, 5, 6) sts, p to end of row – 7 (10, 10, 13) (13, 16, 16, 19) sts.

Row 3: Bind off 1 st, k to end of row – 6 (9, 9, 12) (12, 15, 15, 18) sts.

Row 4: Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4) (4, 5, 5, 6) sts, p to end of row – 4 (6, 6, 8) (8, 10, 10, 12) sts.

Row 5: Knit.

Bind off.

FRONT

With longer circular needle and A, cast on 77 (85, 95, 103) (113, 121, 131, 139) sts.

Row 1: K1, * p1, k1; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) from beg.

Beg with a RS (knit) row, work even in St st for 0 (2, 2, 6) (6, 8, 10, 12) rows.

Intarsia Snowperson Chart

Row 1 (RS): With A, k21 (25, 30, 34) (39, 43, 48, 52), place marker (pm), k35 sts AND change yarn color following Row 1 of Snowperson Chart, pm; with A, k to end of row.

Rows 2-84: With A, work in St st to marker, slip marker (sm), continue in St st AND change yarn color following next row of Snowperson Chart to next marker, sm; with A, k to end of row.

Note: All stitches of Snowperson Chart are worked in St st EXCEPT for the hat band in Rows 72-74 of Chart. Work hat band sts n Rev St st (p on RS, k on WS) as shown in Chart.

Remove markers.

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With A, work even in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures about 16 1/2 (17, 17 1/2, 18) (18 1/2, 19, 19 1/2, 20) in. (42 (43, 44.5, 45.5) (47, 48.5, 49.5, 51) cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Shape Left Neck

Row 1 (RS): K32 (36, 40, 44) (48, 52, 56, 60), place next 13 (13, 15, 15) (17, 17, 19, 19) sts on a holder for front neck, then place rem 32 (36, 40, 44) (48, 52, 56, 60) sts on a holder for right neck and shoulder – 32 (36, 40, 44) (48, 52, 56, 60) sts.

Row 2: Bind off 3 sts, p to end of row – 29 (33, 37, 41) (45, 49, 53, 57) sts.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: Rep Row 2 – 26 (30, 34, 38) (42, 46, 50, 54) sts.

Shape Left Shoulder and Continue to Shape Left Neck

Row 5: Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4) (5, 5, 6, 6) sts, k to end of row -23 (27, 30, 34) (37, 41, 44, 48) sts. **Row 6:** Bind off 2 sts, p to end of row -21 (25, 28, 32) (35, 39, 42, 46) sts. **Rows 7 and 8:** Rep Rows 5 and 6 -16 (20, 22, 26) (28, 32, 34, 38) sts in Row 8. **Row 9:** Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4) (5, 5, 6, 6) sts, k to end of row -13 (17, 18, 22) (23, 27, 28, 32) sts. **Row 10:** Bind off 1 st, p to end of row -12 (16, 17, 21) (22, 26, 27, 31) sts. **Rows 11 and 12:** Rep Rows 9 and 10 -8 (12, 12, 16) (16, 20, 20, 24) sts in Row 12. **Row 13:** Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4) (4, 5, 5, 6) sts, k to end of row -6 (9, 9, 12) (12, 15, 15, 18) sts. **Row 14:** Purl. **Rows 15 and 16:** Rep Rows 13 and 14 -4 (6, 6, 8) (8, 10, 10, 12) sts in Row 15. Bind off.

Shape Right Neck

Return right neck and shoulder sts to needle so that you are ready to work a RS row. **Row 1 (RS):** Bind off 3 sts, k to end of row – 29 (33, 37, 41) (45, 49, 53, 57) sts. **Row 2:** Purl. **Row 3:** Rep Row 1 – 26 (30, 34, 38) (42, 46, 50, 54) sts.

Shape Right Shoulder and Continue to Shape Right Neck

Row 4: Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4) (5, 5, 6, 6) sts, p to end of row – 23 (27, 30, 34) (37, 41, 44, 48) sts.
Row 5: Bind off 2 sts, k to end of row – 21 (25, 28, 32) (35, 39, 42, 46) sts.
Rows 6 and 7: Rep Rows 4 and 5 – 16 (20, 22, 26) (28, 32, 34, 38) sts in Row 7.
Row 8: Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4) (5, 5, 6, 6) sts, p to end of row – 13 (17, 18, 22) (23, 27, 28, 32) sts.
Row 9: Bind off 1 st, k to end of row – 12 (16, 17, 21) (22, 26, 27, 31) sts.

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Row 12: Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4) (4, 5, 5, 6) sts, p to end of row – 6 (9, 9, 12) (12, 15, 15, 18) sts.
Row 13: Knit.
Rows 14 and 15: Rep Rows 12 and 13 – 4 (6, 6, 8) (8, 10, 10, 12) sts in Row 14.
Bind off.

SLEEVES (make 2)

Sleeve Stripe Sequence

* With B, work in St st for 4 rows; with A, work in St st for 6 rows; rep from * for Sleeve Stripe Sequence.

With longer circular needle and E, cast on 46 (48, 50, 50) (52, 52, 54, 54) sts.

Row 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end of row.

Rows 2-4: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Change to A.

With A, rep Row 2 until piece measures about 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) from beg.

Change to B and beg changing yarn color following Sleeve Stripe Sequence. Continue to change yarn color following Sequence until piece is complete.

Beg with a RS (knit) row, work in St st for 10 (8, 8, 6) (6, 4, 4, 4) rows.

Increase Row (RS): K2, M1, k to last 2 sts, M1, k2 – 48 (50, 52, 52) (54, 54, 56, 56) sts.

Work even in St st for 9 (7, 7, 5) (5, 3, 3, 3) rows.

Rep Increase Row – 50 (52, 54, 54) (56, 56, 58, 58) sts.

Rep last 10 (8, 8, 6) (6, 4, 4, 4) rows for 6 (7, 8, 10) (11, 13, 14, 15) more times – 62 (66, 70, 74) (78, 82, 86, 88) sts.

Work even in St st until piece measures about 18 1/2 (18 1/2, 18 1/2, 17 1/2) (17 1/2, 17, 17, 16) in. (47 (47, 47, 44.5) (44.5, 43, 43, 40.5) cm) from beg.

Shape Top of Sleeve

Next 12 rows: Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4) (4, 5, 5, 5) sts, work in St st to end of row – 26 (30, 22, 26) (30, 22, 26, 28) sts when all bind offs have been completed.

Bind off remaining sts.

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BOBBLE

With shorter circular needle and C, cast on 3 sts. **Row 1 (RS):** K1, (k1, yarn over, k1, yarn over, k1) in next st, k1 – 7 sts. **Rows 2-5:** Beg with a WS (purl) row, work in St st for 4 rows. **Row 6:** K1, p2tog, p1, p2tog, k1 – 5 sts. **Row 7:** K1, sk2p, k1 – 3 sts. **Row 8:** Sp2p – 1 st. Fasten off last st.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.

Neckband

From RS, with shorter circular needle and E, beg at right shoulder seam, pick up and k6 sts evenly spaced along right back neck, k31 (31, 33, 33) (35, 35, 37, 37) back neck sts from holder, pick up and k6 sts along left back neck, 17 sts along left front neck, k13 (13, 15, 15) (17, 17, 19, 19) front neck sts from holder, pick up and k17 sts along right front neck – 90 (90, 94, 94) (98, 98, 102, 102) sts.

Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left needle with the working yarn from the right needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Rnds 1-8: * K1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Bind off.

Sew Bobble to top of Snowperson's hat.

Duplicate stitch Embroidery

The snowflakes are worked in duplicate st. A duplicate st is worked over the top of your original st, 'duplicating' the st in a new color.

With B, following Snowflake Chart(s) of your choice, embroider duplicate st snowflakes randomly around snowperson.

Following Snowperson Chart, duplicate st eyes, mouth, and buttons with D, and carrot with E.

Here's how to duplicate st:

- 1. Thread your blunt needle with a 24 in. (61 cm) length of yarn in indicated color.
- 2. Find the first stitch you would like to embroider. You'll see that the sts look like V's.
- 3. Bring your threaded needle through the fabric, from the wrong side out to the right side at the point of the V.
- 4. Now slide the needle under the stitch ABOVE the one you're duplicating.
- 5. Now insert the needle from front to back at the same point you began. You will have made a V in indicated yarn color over the V in the background color!

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- 6. Continue in this same way to embroider all the sts on the chart.
- 7. When you're finished, bring the yarn through to the wrong side of the fabric and knot.

With D, using photograph as a guide, embroider stem stitch arms.

Place markers on sides of Front and Back, about 7 (7 1/2, 8, 8 1/2) (9, 9 1/2, 9 1/2, 10) in. (18 (19, 20.5, 21.5) (23, 24, 24, 25.5) cm) from shoulder seams.

Sew Sleeves between markers.

Sew side and Sleeve seams.

Weave in ends.
