Care Instructions

Spot Cleaning

Any liquid spills should be treated immediately. Place a clean cloth or unprinted paper towel directly onto the spill to absorb as much liquid as possible, then gently dab the area with a clean, damp cloth. Professional Cleaning

Shedding & Lose Fibres

Care & Maintenance

The placement and ongoing care of your rug will have a direct effect on its longevity and appearance. Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight, as this can cause uneven fading over time. Vacuum regularly to prevent dust and dirt from settling deep within the pile, taking care to use a suction-only setting rather than a rotating brush or beater bar, which may damage the longer fibres. High pile rugs may also compress under heavy furniture; consider rotating furniture placement or using furniture coasters to minimise impressions. Rotating your rug occasionally will also help distribute wear more evenly.
