### **SKILL LEVEL** – EASY

# **SIZES**

About 18 in. (45.5 cm) measured along each side edge

#### **MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND® COVER STORY (Art. #533)
   #235 Zephyr 1 cake
- LION BRAND® knitting needles size 11 (8 mm)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size N (10 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



#### **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Fiberfill stuffing

#### **MATERIALS NOTE**

One cake of yarn will make 2 knit pillows or 2 crochet pillows or one of each!

# **GAUGE**

Knit Gauge: 7 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern Rows 1-6.

Crochet Gauge: 7 sts = about 4 1/4 in. (11 cm) over pattern Row 2.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### **NOTE**

Pillow is made as a rectangle, then folded, seamed and stuffed.

#### KNIT PILLOW

Cast on 32 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Rows 3 and 4: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Row 5: Purl.

Row 6: Knit.

Rep Rows 1-6 until piece measures about 36 in. (91.5 cm) from beg, end with a Row 4 of pattern as the last row you work.

Bind off.

#### **CROCHET PILLOW**

Ch 32.

**Row 1 (RS):** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch do not count as a st) and in each ch across – you will have 30 hdc in this row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each st across.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 36 in. (91.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

**Note:** Finishing is the same whether your pillow is knit or crocheted.

Fold rectangle in half and sew short side edges together, leaving top edge unsewn.

At open top edge, bring side seams together at center.

Sew top edge closed (this top seam will be crosswise to the side seams), stuffing Pillow before finishing. Weave in ends.
