

On chairs, avoid improper use such as sitting on the back or armrests, tilting the seats on their back legs, putting your feet on the furniture or standing on it. On tables tighten up the screws after one or two months use. Be careful not to damage or scratch the surface with sharp objects. Minor spots of rust under the furniture and bases are considered as a natural result of general use and can be treated using the care instructions. Direct placement on a seafront can lead to corrosion. Wipe o bird droppings quickly as they may lead to staining or permanent corrosion

Wipe off the furniture if it becomes wet after rain or snowfall as this will damage the surface over time. Sharp tips and points can also appear on the surface, which can be removed with a metal file. Take care not to scratch the chairs against each other when stacking them. Do not move or drag the chairs around when stacked as the weight will damage the legs.

Powder Coated Steel

Wipe with a clean cloth wrung in water or in a solution of water and a neutral detergent. Remove soap residue immediately using a clean dry cloth. Avoid using scouring cream or scouring pads, as they may scratch the surface. Minor scratches or damage to the powder coated surfaces can lead to corrosion.

Storage

The life expectancy of your furniture will vary depending on the weather and type of use. We recommend that you store it in a dry, ventilated place during winter and keep it protected from scratches and bumps.


Assembly instructions







When the steel base and tabletop are put together, screw the last tw lamellas on with the B screws
