ABOUT OUR CHENIN BLANC

Our Tower 15, 2017 Chenin Blanc is versatile in its style and sweetness and highlighted by bright acidity, proving to be a wine for every occasion. The small quantity of grapes are grown on the Area 51 Vineyard, located along the scenic Foxen Canyon Trail in Santa Barbara County. This wine is fermented and aged in a combination of neutral French oak barrels and stainless steel barrels for 240 days.

WINEMAKER NOTES

Hay colored with excellent clarity and sparkled character, this Chenin Blanc begins with aromas of honeysuckle and crush chalk with a focused palate showing flavors of pear and citrus.
