Winegrower's note

Heresie redefines the Corbières wines. It is the expression of a vintage from the Corbières, that symbolizes and transcends the story of the knights from the South of France. This wine is a strong and innovative concept, strongly appreciated by the millenials.



Winemaker's note

The grape varieties are vinified separately, traditionally, with a vatting period of 10 days.

The Grenache Noir is entirely destemmed and the maceration at a lower temperature for 5 days allows the fruit to express itself, giving elegance and roundness to the wine. The wines are racked at the end of the malolactic fermentation.





Tasting notes

The colour is a deep purple red. The nose is beautifully complex, with notes of red fruits and spices. The Syrah brings the aromas of fruits and spices, the Mourvèdre the notes of liquorice. The palate is balanced with great freshness and velvety tannins.

To be enjoyed at 18°C with a roast rack of lamb, game birds or mature cheeses.
