
Terra Firma is made with care and skill. Raw yarns are refined to create timeless textiles that embrace the imperfect beauty of nature.

FORAGE CLOTH

A robust textured rib that combines utilitarian practicality with the art of nature. A unique blend of linen and wool combine to create a tonal mélange on the face of the cloth whilst sturdy raw linen yarns are interwoven at the back, giving a pronounced texture. Perfect for upholstery this cloth has a dense, dry hand and is available in a range of soft, earthy pigments.

DRIFTWOOD

This cloth appears raw and weathered, embracing the beauty of imperfection. With an organic texture that is delicate in appearance but strong in structure, yarns of different densities are interlaced to create a substantial double width sheer. Linen fibres of varied hues are twisted together to create dappled, tonal colourways with faint slubs and flecks.
