TIGERS' HIDEOUT



FACT ONE

ONLY ONE IN TEN HUNTS ARE SUCCESSFUL

A tiger will typically travel 6-12 miles during a night's hunting. Tigers hunt on their own and stalk and ambush their prey.

Tigers need to be within 20m of their prey before making the final dash. A tiger's leap can be over 5 metres long. They rely on explosive acceleration to catch their prey and rarely chase it beyond a distance of 150 metres.

FACT TWO



TIGERS CAN CATCH PREY FIVE TIMES THEIR OWN WEIGHT

While their main prey is deer, Tigers are opportunistic hunters that eat some unexpected items - including birds, fish, rodents, insects, amphibians and reptiles.

FACT THREE

TIGERS HAVE A VAST VOCAL REPERTOIRE

Tigers can grunt, growl, roar, moan, snarl, chuff, hiss and gasp. It's thought that each vocalisation is used to communicate different things.

Tigers have scent glands around their whiskers, cheeks, chin and lips, as well as at the base of their tail and between their toes. Tigers rub these against objects like trees to scent mark.



INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1

Fill about three-quarters of the planter with some sieved peat-free soil or multi-purpose compost, which you can buy from garden centres. The soil or compost needs to be damp. Press the soil down to make a flat surface, and make sure you don't cover the cross pin in the planter.



STEP 2

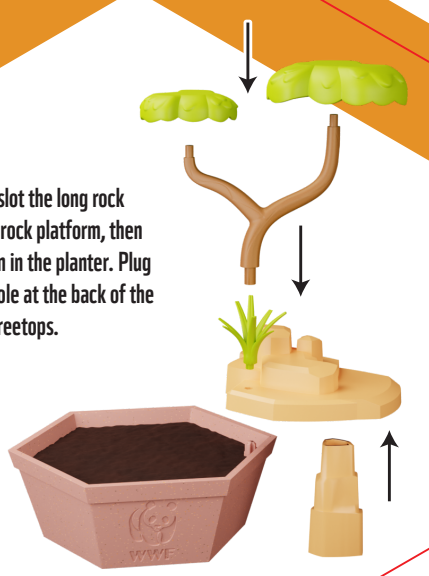
Evenly scatter the grass seeds from the packet into the planter.



STEP 3

To assemble the playset, slot the long rock onto the underside of the rock platform, then attach this to the cross pin in the planter. Plug the tree branch into the hole at the back of the platform and pop on the treetops.

Finish by placing the grass tuft into the other small hole. Your Tigers' Hideout is complete!



STEP 4

Place the pot on a warm windowsill or similarly in a well-lit position and water regularly.

At night when the temperature drops, remove the playset and use the plastic dome as a propagator to keep the plants warm and encourage the seedlings to grow.



STEP 5

Your grass should be fully grown in about 3-4 days. If the grass gets too long, you can trim with scissors, but make sure you ask an adult to help with this.
