## **CLEANING GUIDE**

## **Easy Care**

Wool is antistatic and does not attract dirt like other fabrics. It is also water-repellant, so spillages are slow to penetrate the fabric. To maintain the appearance of the fabric, we recommend gentle vacuuming, preferably every week, with a soft nozzle.

## Stain Removal

\*\*Always remove stains as quickly as possible\*\*

Most stains and dirt can be removed using an ordinary pH-neutral detergent diluted in lukewarm water at normal strengths (follow pack instructions)

- First, soak up as much of the liquid as possible with a soft white cloth.
- If the stain has dried on, remove as much residue as possible with a vacuum.
- Rub carefully with a soft white cloth; do not use abrasive cloths.
- Press the fabric with a dry, soft white cloth or kitchen roll every time water is added to soak up moisture and dirt.
- Use clean water without any detergent for the final clean.

(The area may appear darker than the surrounding fabric after being cleaned with water, but should become less noticeable over time)

If the stain resists spot cleaning, contact a professional cleaner. Commercial settings may require more frequent cleaning following care guide instructions. Please get in touch to request a fabric sample or if you have any questions about caring for your Tom Raffield product.
