INSTALLATION OF TIP CONNECTORS:

CAUTION: Before cutting skins make sure that the skin is oriented correctly for uphill traction and downhill glide.

1. Remove the release liner on the adhesive side of the skins.
2. Attach and adjust tail clip (not included) to ski and place skin on ski base.
3. Place tip loop on ski, midway up the tip. Tip loops positioned too high on the ski tip may be kicked off during use. Tip loops too far down may drag in the snow. Flip tip loops to match best fit of ski width.
4. Mark skin where tip loop contacts adhesive and remove skin from ski, trim off excess skin 9 cm (3.5 in) above your fold mark.
5. Fold skin at mark and trim fabric to width of tip loop.
6. Place tip loop on adhesive surface at the fold mark. Fold the adhesive side of the fabric over the tip loop and back onto itself to hold tip loop in place.
