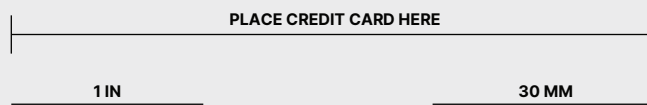


# Local Eclectic

## Ring Sizing Guide

### IMPORTANT NOTE BEFORE YOU PRINT

- Before printing this ring sizing guide, make sure that page scaling is set to 100% in your printer settings area.
- If the measurement isn't accurate, please review your print settings again. Be sure you are printing 100% scale. Use the below scale to confirm correct scaling - the length of the top bar is comparable to a credit card, or use a rule to measure 1 inch/30mm.

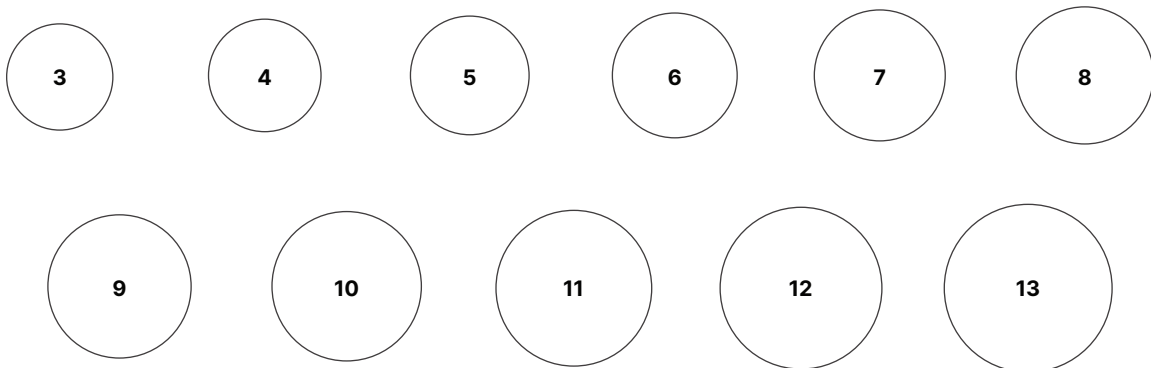


### METHOD 1

For 100% accurate ring sizing, we recommend visiting a jeweler. Any professional jeweler will be able to help you find your perfect ring size.

### METHOD 2

Place a ring that fits you on the circles below. For proper fit make sure that the black circle is completely visible within your ring, that will be your ring size. To double-check, place your ring on the next larger size, you should not be able to see the entire black circle.



If you are between sizes, we recommend sizing up to the nearest full size.  
For example, if you are a 6.5, size up to a 7.
