Maintenance & Care

- 1. To clean the products surface use clean hot soapy water. ONLY use soft fabric cloths.
- 2. DO NOT use cleaning solutions that contain hydrochloric acid, formic acid, concentrated caustic soda, chlorine or acetic acid as they can cause considerable damage.
- 3. DO NOT use any coarse cleaning powders or brushes to clean the product.
- 4. If there is irregular water pressure & water flow is reduced, please check if the hose is clean, if not brush the spout after vinegar soaking.

Troubleshooting

Fault: Hot is coming out when I select cold or vise versa:

Cause: Hot and cold pipes are connected the wrong way around.

Fault: Fluctuating flow rate:

Cause: Possible blockage in the system or operating conditions is incorrect.

Fault: Low or no flow from the valve:

Cause: Possible blockage in the system, operating conditions is incorrect or there


is a blockage in the system.

- 3. Secure the slide rail kit to the fixings, using the allen keys provided.
- 4. Connect the hose to the water outlet and the hand shower head.
- 5. Check for any leaks.
