
# If you are experiencing leaking, follow these steps to resolve:

#### Leaking from clean water tank


• Go to Clean Water Tank

#### Leaking from dirty water tank or vents

• Remove front assembly



- Empty tank by opening drain plug over sink
- Push drain plug securely into place



• When front assembly is removed, a small amount of liquid may drip from machine, this is normal

### Check grey gasket (behind front assembly) for damage or debris


- If gasket is warped or damaged > Contact Us
- If gasket is intact, reattach front assembly
- Leaking from the side vents can happen if:



- o The machine is used upside-down










**Incorrect Positions**
