# **OWNER'S MANUAL**

- 1. Read this manual carefully before starting assembly. Read each step completely before beginning each step.
- 2. Some smaller parts may be shipped inside larger parts. Check inside all parts and cartons before assembling or ordering parts.
- 3. If hardware is tightened too soon, mounting holes may not align and parts may not easily fit together. Leave bolts slightly loose until you are instructed to tighten them.
- 4. Tools required for assembly: Wrenches or adjustable wrenches (not provided) are helpful.
- 5. To make assembly as easy as possible, place all parts of the table tennis in a cleared area and remove the packaging material. Organize all parts as per parts identifier in the assembly manual. Do not dispose of the packing material until assembly is completed.
- 6. Avoid scratching table tennis top and metal tube parts during the assembly process.
- 7. Assemble product on clean, level and flat surface.
- 8. Take time to correctly orientate parts exactly as per each assembly diagram.
- 9. Save this instruction in the event that the manufacturer has to be contacted for replacement parts.

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## **CARE AND MAINTENANCE**

You have purchased a quality product that will give you years of enjoyment. By following these simple maintenance steps, you will add to the life of your new table.

### THE TABLE TOP

The top (playing surface) of your table is made of Mid-Density Board. Like all products made of wood, it can be affected by atmospheric changes in both temperature and humidity. This may cause a slight sag or distortion as the top expands or contracts. This is normal and should not cause concern as it does not detract from the play or utility value of the table. After assembly of the table, you can minimize the effects of temperature and humidity changes by storing the table in a dry area when table is not in use.

### STORAGE OF YOUR TABLE

This table must be stored indoors to prevent damage to the playing surface. Dampness and extreme temperature changes can cause the wood to warp, swell, crack or blister. When your table is not in use, it should be stored in a dry area. Due to the nature of particle board, table top may bow. Damp and humid conditions will amplify this. This is normal and will not affect playability of table.

### **CLEANING YOUR TABLE**

To clean your table use a soft, damp (NOT WET) cloth only. To prevent damage to your table's playing surface, DO NOT USE ANY CHEMICALS, ABRASIVE OR CLEANING PRODUCTS on your table's playing surface.

### MAINTENANCE OF YOUR TABLE

Be sure to oil all moving parts of your table including the pivot points. This will insure the safety and ease of use of your table.


This table must be kept indoors to prevent damage to the playing surface. Dampness and extreme temperature changes which occur on patios or similar areas can cause wood to warp, swell, crack or blister.

#### **UNLEVEL FLOORS**


If table does not seem level, it is probably due to uneven or unlevel floors. Set the table in its PLAYING POSITION and move table several inches in different directions to find the best location for the table. If the floor is extremely unlevel, table may not play or operate properly. If table is high in the center, shim up under the outer legs.

The table has leg levelers - Adjust leg levelers as required.



IMPORTANT NOTE: Place table half top with playing surface face down on a CLEAN flat surface for ease of correct assembly and to prevent any scratches or blemishes to the playing surface.

## PARTS REQUIRED


2 pcs - **P1** Half Table Tennis Top Assembled

- 4 pcs H1 8mm x 65mm Hex Head Bolt
- 8 pcs H2 8.5mm x 20mm Flat Washer
- 4 pcs **H3** M8 Nylock Nut 4 pcs - **H5** M8 Lock Washer

1 pc - **T2** 13mm Wrench 1 pc - **T3** 14mm Wrench

## STEP 1:

Attach both P1 Half Table Tennis Top Assembled using H1 Bolts, H5 Lock Washers, H2 Flat Washers and H3 Nylock Nuts as shown in FIGURE 1 and DETAIL A. IMPORTANT NOTE! Make sure table halfs are aligned and flat before moving to STEP 2.




### PARTS REQUIRED

2 pcs - P6 Cross Support Tube

28 pcs - H10 4mm x 63mm Phillips Round Head Screw

## STEP 2:

Make sure table halfs are aligned and flat before attaching P6 Cross Support Tubes. Attach two P6 Cross Support Tube using H10 Screws as shown in FIGURE 2. Do not strip out H10 screws.



### PARTS REQUIRED


2 pcs - **P2** Left Leg Side Panel 2 pcs - **P3** Right Leg Side Panel 2 pcs - **P4** Left Leg Front Panel 2 pcs - **P5** Right Leg Front Panel

12 pcs - **H11** 6mm x 35mm Allen Head Bolt 12 pcs - **H12** 6.5mm x 18mm Flat Washer 1 pc - T1 Allen Wrench

## **STEP 3:**

Attach P2 Left Leg Side Panels to P4 Left Leg Front Panels using H11 Bolts and H12 Flat Washers as shown in FIGURE 3. Tighten H11 Bolts using T1 Wrench.


Attach P3 Right Leg Side Panels to P5 Right Leg Front Panels using H11 Bolts and H12 Flat Washers as shown in FIGURE 3. Tighten H11 Bolts using T1 Wrench.




## STEP 4:

Attach **P10** Triangle Leg End Caps onto each Leg Assembly from **STEP 3** using pre-drilled holes with **H8** Screws as shown in **FIGURE 4** and **DETAIL B. DO NOT STRIP OUT H8 SCREWS.** 


Attach **P11** Leg Support Brackets onto each Leg Assembly from **STEP 3** using pre-drilled holes with **H9** Screws as shown in **FIGURE 4** and **DETAIL C. DO NOT STRIP OUT H9 SCREWS**.






## STEP 6:

Attach **P8** Long Side Leg Support Panels and **P9** Short End Leg Support Panels to Legs using **H7** Bolts, **H5** Lock Washers, **H2** Flat Washers and **H3** Nylock Nuts as shown in **FIGURE 6, DETAIL F** and **DETAIL G**. **TIGHTEN ALL H4 & H6 (FROM STEP 5) AND H7 BOLTS ON THIS TIME.**
