



Step 1


- · Attach Legs (2) to "H"-shaped section.
- Do not fully tighten the screws. You will fully tighten screws when Bike Stand is completely assembled.


Step 2

- · Attach Straight Poles (2) to the top of the "H"-shaped section.
- · Do not fully tighten the screws.



Step 3

- · Attach "U"-shaped section to the Straight Poles (2).
- \cdot Legs facing forward (away from wall), "U"-shaped section optional Safety Anchor facing the wall.
- · Do not fully tighten the screws.




Step 4

· Tighten all screws before using.



Step 5


- · Install and adjust the height of the arms before loading the bike.
 - 5A Mount the hook as shown twist the hook and lower the Arm at the same time.
 - \cdot 5B Make sure the hook is centered on the upright, push arm down.
 - 5C Push Arm down firmly to seat it. The Arm may not be horizontal until loaded with bike (due to the rubber coating).
- The arms do not have to be horizontal with one another.
- Size up your bike to the width of the arms, estimate bike mounting position, adjust arms, test load bike, adjust to satisfaction.

⚠ IMPORTANT!

- To avoid accidental toppling of the rack, a wall anchor/stabilizing strap is attached to the rack from the factory.
- The other end of the strap should be anchored to the wall using a screw/bolt that is suitable for the type of wall construction. The screw/bolt to do so is not included with this rack.
- If you are unsure how to attach it to the wall or if any questions, we strongly suggest you consult with your hardware store expert for the correct method of attachment based on your wall construction.
