1. Please update the firmware with PIXAPRO firmware update software G2. G2 can be downloaded on the [essentialphoto](http://essentialphoto.co.uk) website.
2. To Check Firmware Version: Press the "MENU" button to enter the menu, and the firmware update version (e.g. Version 1.4) will be displayed on the LCD panel.
