Overview:

Offered in an array of styles, colors, and shapes, porcelain ceramic sinks feature many unique benefits, including their heavy duty feel and classy, sophisticated looks, while offering an integral overflow in almost all of the models available. Porcelain ceramic sinks are easy to clean and maintain. They can be enjoyed indefinitely with a little bit of regular care and maintenance.

The following types of cleaners should never be used:

- Coarse cleaners with grit (Ajax)
- Acidic chemicals
- Alcohol-based cleaners

The following types of cleaners should never be used:

- Steel wool
- Brillo pads
- Pumice products
- Wire brushes

In order to prolong the life of your porcelain ceramic sink, simple daily maintenance is the key to keeping your sink in its original condition. Clean your sink after each use with a soapy sponge, then rinse thoroughly with warm water. Dry with a towel or soft cloth. This will eliminate water spots and streaks while the sink is in use.
