EASY

SIZES

XS/S (M/L, 1X/2X, 3X/4X)

Finished Chest About 38 (46, 54, 62) in. (96.5 (117, 137, 157.5) cm)

Finished Length About 26 (27, 28, 29) in. (66 (68.5, 71, 73.5) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® HOMETOWN® (Art. #135)
#135 Stowe Sugar Maple 8 (10, 12, 14) balls
#098 Houston Cream 1 (1, 1, 1) ball
#122 Highland Park Beige 1 (1, 1, 1) ball
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® stitch holders
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle, size 13 (9 mm), 40 in. (100 cm) long or longer
4 buttons, 1 in. (12-13 mm) diameter

GAUGE

9 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over St st (k on RS, p on WS).

22 rows = about 7 in. (18 cm) over St st.
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

M1 (make 1) An increase worked by lifting the horizontal strand lying between needles and placing it onto the left needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop – 1 st increased.

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to

knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them together – 1 st decreased.

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle.
This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES

1. Cardigan is worked in one piece from the lower edge upwards.
2. Pocket linings and sleeves are worked separately then joined to body of Cardigan as work progresses.
3. The stars and horseshoe motifs are worked in intarsia colorwork, following the included charts.
4. When working intarsia, use a separate ball of yarn for each color section, don't carry colors across WS of work.
5. A circular needle is used to accommodate sts. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working with straight needles.
6. This cozy Cardigan can be made without the intarsia motifs should you prefer.

POCKET LININGS (make 2)

With A, cast on 12 sts.

Work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) for 18 rows.
Cut yarn, slip sts to a holder and set linings aside.

SLEEVES (make 2)

With A, cast on 28 (28, 30, 30) sts.
Knit 3 rows.

Beg with a RS (knit) row, work in St st for 12 (8, 6, 4) rows.

Next row (RS): K2, M1, k to last 2 sts, M1, k2 – you will have 30 (30, 32, 32) sts in this row.

Next row: Purl.

Rep the last 14 (10, 8, 6) rows 2 (4, 4, 6) more times – 34 (38, 40, 44) sts.

Work even in St st until piece measures about 17 1/2 (18, 18 1/2, 19) in. (44.5 (45.5, 47, 48.5) cm) from beg.

Shape Top of Sleeve

Next row: Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4) sts, k to last 3 (3, 4, 4) sts, bind off last 3 (3, 4, 4) sts – 28 (32, 32, 36) sts.

Cut yarn, slip sts to a holder and set sleeve aside.

BODY

With A, cast on 92 (110, 128, 146) sts.

Knit 3 rows.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: K6, p to last 6 sts, k6.

Rows 3 and 4: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Row 5 (buttonhole row): K3, yo, k2tog, k to end of row.

Rows 6-14: Keeping first and last 6 sts in Garter st (k every st of every row), work in St st for 9 rows.

Make Pocket Openings

Row 15: Knit.

Row 16: K6, p4 (6, 8, 10), k12, p48 (62, 76, 90), k12, p4 (6, 8, 10), k6.

Rows 17 and 18: Rep Rows 15 and 16.

Row 19 (buttonhole row): K3, yo, k2tog, k5 (7, 9, 11), bind off 12 sts (for pocket), k48 (62, 76, 90), bind off 12 sts (for pocket), k4 (6, 8, 10), k6 – 68 (86, 104, 120) sts and 2 pocket openings.

Join Pocket Linings

Row 20 (WS): K6, p4 (6, 8, 10); from WS of one Pocket Lining, p12 sts from holder, p48 (62, 76, 90); from WS of 2nd Pocket Lining, p12 sts from holder, p4 (6, 8, 10), k6.

Charted Star Pattern

Next row (RS): Knit.

Set-Up row (WS): K6, p3 (5, 7, 9), place marker (pm), p13, pm, p8 (12, 17, 22), pm, p13, pm, p6 (12, 16, 20), pm, p13, pm, p8 (12, 17, 22), pm, p13, pm, p3 (5, 7, 9), k6.

Row 1 (RS): (K to next marker, sm, k13 AND change yarn color following Row 1 of Star Chart, sm) 4 times, k to end of row.

Row 2: K6, (p to next marker, sm, p13 AND change yarn color following next row of Star Chart, sm) 4 times, p to last 6 sts, k6.

Rows 3-12: Keeping first and last 6 sts in Garter st, work in St st AND change yarn color following next row of Star Chart over each set of 13 sts between markers.

Row 13 (buttonhole row): K3, yo, k2tog, (k to next marker, sm, k next 13 sts AND change yarn color following next row of Star Chart, sm) 4 times, k to end of row.

Keeping first and last 6 sts in Garter st, work in St st AND change yarn color following next row of Star Chart over each set of 13 sts between markers until all rows of Star Chart have been completed.

Cut B. Continue with A only.

Charted Horseshoe Pattern

Next row (RS): Keeping first and last 6 sts in Garter st, work in St st and remove Star Chart markers.

Set-Up row (WS): K6, p29 (38, 47, 56), pm, p22, pm, p to last 6 sts, k6.

Row 1 (RS): K to first marker, sm, k22 AND change yarn color following Row 1 of Horseshoe Chart, sm, k to end of row.

Row 2: K6, p to first marker, sm, p22 AND change yarn color following next row of Horseshoe Chart, sm, p to last 6 sts, k6.

Rows 3-8: Keeping first and last 6 sts in Garter st, work in St st AND change yarn color following next row of Horseshoe Chart over center 22 sts between markers.

Shape Armholes

Notes

1. As you continue to make the Cardigan, continue to change yarn color following Horseshoe Chart over center 22 sts until all rows of Horseshoe Chart have been completed. When Chart rows are complete, remove the markers, cut C and complete the Cardigan with A only.
2. Slip markers as you come to them.
3. More markers are added when joining Sleeves to indicate raglan decrease locations and when shaping shawl collar. Use different color markers for raglan locations, collar shaping locations, and Horseshoe Chart to make it easier to see when to work raglan decreases, shape the collar or work the next row of the Horseshoe Chart.

Row 9 (buttonhole row): K3, yo, k2tog, k19 (24, 28, 34), bind off 4 (4, 5, 5) sts, k36 (44, 52, 58), bind off 4 (4, 5, 5) sts, k24 (29, 33, 39).

Join Sleeves

Row 10: K6, p18 (23, 27, 33), pm (for raglan decreases); from WS of one sleeve, p28 (32, 32, 36) Sleeve sts from one holder, pm, p36 (44, 52, 58), pm; from WS of 2nd Sleeve, p28 (32, 32, 36) Sleeve sts from second holder, pm, p18 (23, 27, 33), k6 - 140 (166, 182, 208) sts.

Shape Yoke and Shawl Collar

Row 1 (RS): K6, M1, pm (for collar), k2tog, (k to 3 sts before next raglan marker, ssk, k1, sm, k1, k2tog) 4 times, k to last 8 sts, ssk, pm (for collar), M1, k6 - 132 (158, 174, 200) sts (7 collar sts and 118 (144, 160, 186) yoke sts)

Next 3 rows: Working in Garter st over sts before first collar marker and after last collar marker, work in St st between markers.

Next row (RS): K to first collar marker, M1, sm, k2tog, (k to 3 sts before raglan marker, ssk, sm, k1 k2tog) 4 times, k to 2 sts before last collar marker, ssk, sm, M1, k to end of row - 124 (150, 166, 192) sts. (8 collar sts and 108 (134, 150, 176) yoke sts)

Next row: K to first collar marker, sm, p to last collar marker, sm, k to end of row.
Rep last 6 rows 2 (2, 1, 1) more time(s) - 92 (118, 150, 176) sts (12, 12, 10, 10) collar sts, 68 (94, 130, 156) yoke sts) when all repeats have been completed.

Next row (RS): K to first collar marker, M1, sm, k2tog, (k to 3 sts before raglan marker, ssk, sm, k1 k2tog) 4 times, k to 2 sts before last collar marker, ssk, sm, M1, k to end of row - 84 (110, 142, 168) sts (13 (13, 11, 11) collar sts and 58 (84, 120, 146) yoke sts)

Next 3 (1, 1, 1) row(s): Working in Garter st over sts before first collar marker and after last collar marker, work in St st between markers.
Rep last 4 (2, 2, 2) rows 0 (2, 4, 6) more times - 84 (94, 110, 120) sts (13 (15, 15, 17) collar sts and 58 (64, 80, 86) yoke sts). Note: When you see '0' repeats in an instruction, this means that for that size, you should not perform that particular instruction, just skip to the next instruction.

Next row (RS): (K to 3 sts before next raglan marker, ssk, k1, sm, k1, k2tog) 4 times, k to end of row - 76 (86, 102, 112) sts. (13 (15, 15, 17) collar sts and 50 (56, 72, 78) yoke sts)

Next row: K to first collar marker, sm, p to last collar marker, sm, k to end of row.
Rep last 2 rows 2 (3, 5, 5) more times - 60 (62, 62, 72) sts (13 (15, 15, 17) collar sts and 34 (32, 32, 38) yoke sts).

Next row (RS): K to first collar marker and place these sts on a holder for right collar, bind off all sts to last collar marker and remove raglan markers, k to end of row - 13 (15, 15, 17) sts rem on needle for left collar.

Left Collar

Next row (WS): K to last left collar st, M1, k1 – 14 (16, 16, 18) sts.

Work in Garter st for 44 (50, 50, 56) rows (22 (25, 25, 28) Garter ridges).

Bind off.

Right Collar

Next row (WS): From WS and working over right collar sts on holder, k1, M1, k to end of collar sts – 14 (16, 16, 18) sts.

Work in Garter st for 44 (50, 50, 56) rows (22 (25, 25, 28) Garter ridges).

Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew ends of left and right collar together.

Sew neck edge of collar to Cardigan neck edge.

Sew Sleeve and underarm seams.

Sew edges of Pocket Linings to WS of Cardigan fronts.

Sew buttons opposite buttonholes.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

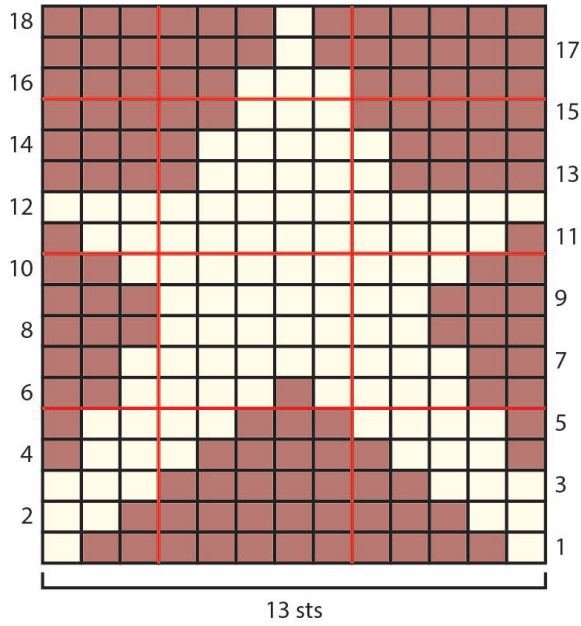
St st = Stockinette stitch

WS = wrong side
