



# COLORPLAY MITTENS

Skill Level: **EASY**

**SIZES**

Adult S (M, L)

**Finished Hand Circumference** About 7 (7 1/2, 8) in. (18 (19, 20.5 cm)

**Finished Length** About 9 1/2 (10, 11) in. (24 (25.5, 28) cm), including 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) cuff

**MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND® LB COLLECTION® SUPERWASH MERINO (Art. #486)
  - #111 Midnight Blue 1 ball (A)
  - #173 Sage 1 ball (B)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

**ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)

**GAUGE**

20 sc + 23 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

**STITCH EXPLANATION**

**sc2tog (sc 2 sts together)** (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

**NOTES**

1. Mittens begin with a ribbed cuff worked in rows.
2. The cuff is joined into a circle, then Mitten is worked in continuous rnds (spiral) from cuff upwards.
3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Do not cut old color until instructed. Carry color not in use carefully up the WS of the Mitten.

**MITTENS (make 2)**

With A, ch 14.

**Cuff**

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 13 sts in this row.

**Rows 2-34 (36, 38):** Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each st to last st, sc in both loops of last st.

Fold piece in half, matching sts of last row and foundation ch.

**Joining**

Working through both thicknesses, slip st in each st across to join ribbing into a circle. Note: Sts of last row and foundation ch can be sewn together, if you prefer.

Do not fasten off. Turn cuff so that seam (joining row) is on the inside.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** With A, ch 1, work 34 (36, 38) sc evenly spaced along edge of ribbing; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral) – 34 (36, 38) sts.

Change to B. Cut A.

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnds 2-5:** With B, sc in each st around.

**Shape Thumb Gusset**

**Rnd 1:** Sc in first 15 (16, 17) sts, 2 sc in next st, place marker (pm) in last sc made, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, pm in first sc of 2-sc just made, sc in last 15 (16, 17) sts – 36 (38, 40) sts.

**Rnd 2:** Sc in each st to next marked st, 2 sc in marked st and move marker to last sc made, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in marked st and move marker to first sc of 2-sc just made, sc in each st to end of rnd – 38 (40, 42) sts.

**Rnd 3:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnds 4 and 5:** Rep Rnd 2 twice – 42 (44, 46) sts in Rnd 5.

**Rnd 6:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnds 7-12:** Rep Rnds 4-6 twice – 50 (52, 54) sts in Rnd 11:



Rep Rnds 2 and 3 for 0 (0, 1) time(s) – 50 (52, 56) sts. Note: When you see '0' repeats in an instruction, this means that for that size, you should not perform that particular instruction, just skip to the next instruction.

### Hand

**Rnd 1:** Sc in first 18 (19, 20) sts, skip next 14 (14, 16) sts (thumb opening made), sc in last 18 (19, 20) sts – 36 (38, 40) sts.

**Rnds 2-16 (18, 20):** Sc in each st around.

Change to A. Cut B.

**Next 2 rows:** With A, sc in each st around.

### Shape Top of Mitten

Flatten Mitten so that thumb opening is flat and lying to one side of hand. Place a marker in st at each side edge of hand so that there are 17 (18, 19) sts between marked sts.

**Rnd 1:** With A, \* sc in each st to 2 sts before next marker, (sc2tog) twice and move marker to last sc2tog made; rep from \* once more, sc in each st to end of rnd – 32 (34, 36) sts.  
Rep Rnd 1 for 6 more times – 8 (10, 12) sts when all decreases have been completed.

**Next rnd:** \* Sc2tog; rep from \* to end of rnd – 4 (5, 6) sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts. Pull tail to close opening at top of Mitten. Knot securely.

### Thumb

**Rnd 1:** From RS, join B with sc in edge of Mitten immediately before skipped thumb opening sts, sc in each thumb opening st – 15 (15, 17) sts.  
Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnds 2 and 3:** With B, sc in each st around.  
Change to A. Cut B.

**Rnds 4-11:** With A, sc in each st around.

**Rnd 12:** Sc in first st, (sc2tog) around – 8 (8, 9) sts.

**Rnd 13:** (Sc2tog) 4 times, sc in last 0 (0, 1) st – 4 (4, 5) sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts. Pull tail to close opening at top of thumb.  
Knot securely.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
