

1. Print, preferably on cardstock.
2. Use a paper cutter to cut each page in fourths, creating four flashcards. 3. Laminate for durability.

## Uses

1. Use in small groups/intervention to assess students. You can ask students to: identify each number, match each number with the right ten frame card, arrange the numbers in the correct order, count the ten frames for one-to-one correspondence, show their understanding of greater than/less than, etc.
2. Shuffle number cards, pick one, say it aloud and have students write the number and/or draw the number of objects on a personal white board. 3. Play a memory match game.
