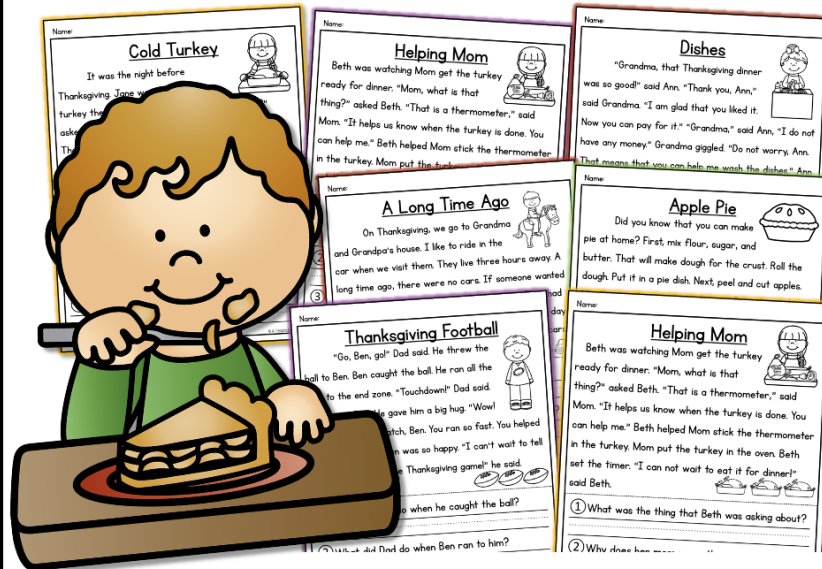

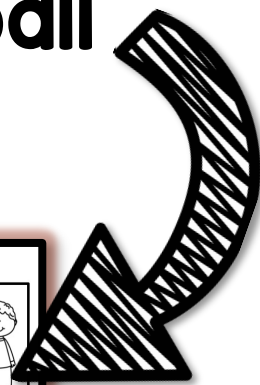
Wishbone
