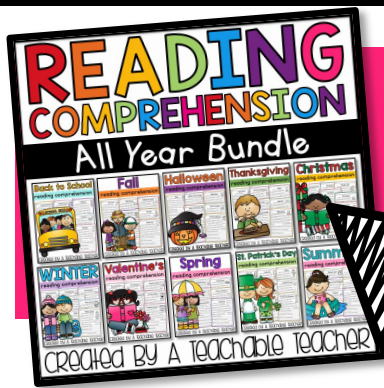
The End of a Rainbow
