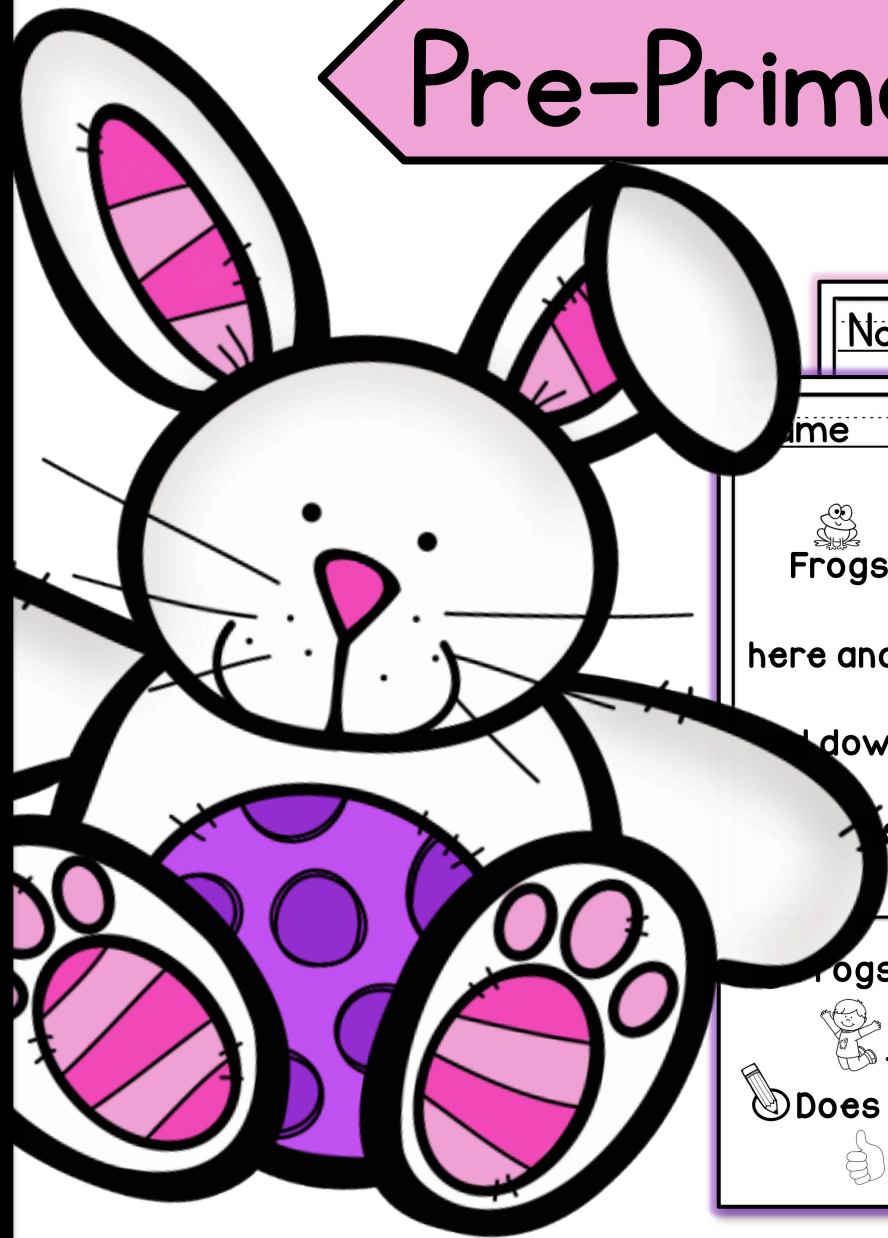

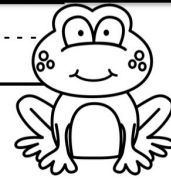

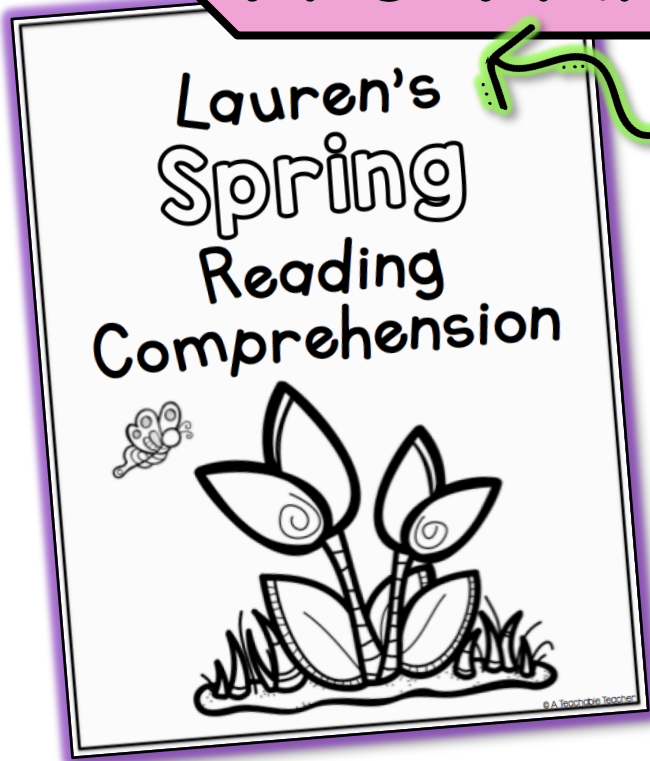

### Pre-Primer and Primer

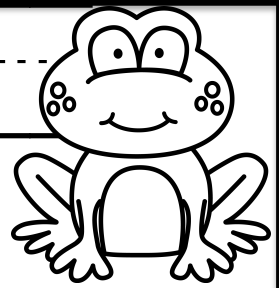
