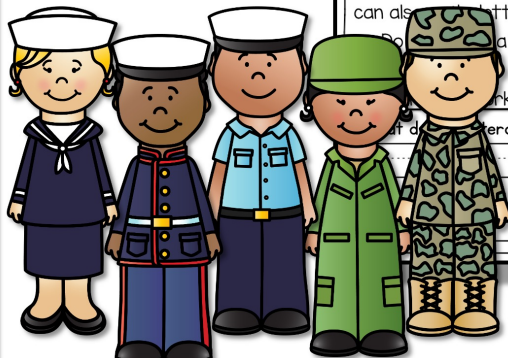

Our military keep us safe. There are many groups in the military.


Each group is called a branch. The five main branches are the Marine Corps, the Navy, the Army, the Air Force, and the Coast Guard. These five work together to keep our country safe.




Memorial Day
