

Teacher Helper

Your students are going to LOVE these Word Family Mazes! These mazes give your students the opportunity to practice blending sounds, reading CVC words and building fluency. Once you explain the directions to your students, they will be able to independently use these mazes for centers, word work, independent work, morning work, and even a fun homework assignment! Here is how it works:

Start at the bolt.



Look for a word in the designated word family. Words must be touching side to side, and not at a corner.

Students need to work their way to the robot.

Once students have read and colored their way through the maze, they can practice reading the path. When they read, they are practicing rhyming and fluency. *Challenge students by asking them to read all

the words in the mazé, even the ones that do not belong in the word family!
