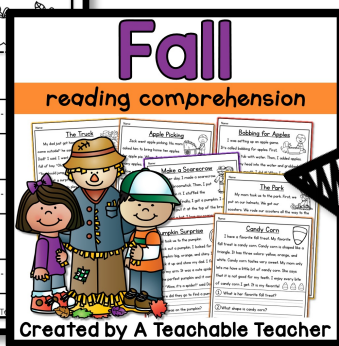
Bobbing for Apples

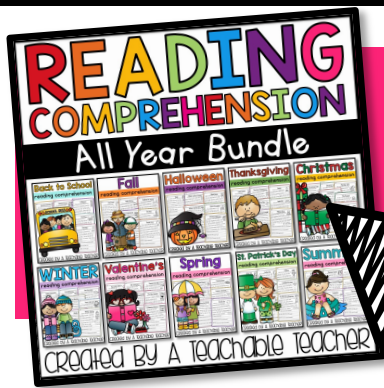

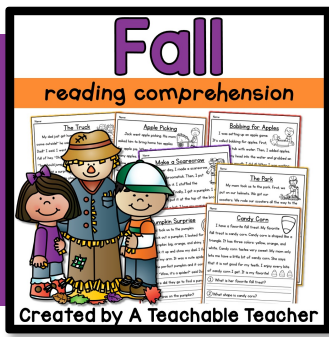
