

What do I get?

- directions

multiple writing prompts




What do I need?

- colored construction paper cut down to 9X12
- sequins (optional)
- soissors
- glue and/or glue stick

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Directions

- 1. First, make sure you have colored paper. It should be out 9x12.
- 2. Oopy/out the treasure chest and writing paper as directed on the templates.
- 3. Lay the colored paper in front of you in a portrait orientation. Glue the bottom of the chest to the bottom of the paper.
- 4. Fold the top of the colored paper down until it reaches the top of the chest.
- 5. Glue the top of the chest on the folded paper.









- 6. Color and/or decorate the treasure chest.
- 7. Open the chest and glue in the writing paper. (This was the last step for my students they had the writing completed beforehand.)
