

We use 1 poem for the entire week and complete different activities each day (highlight sight words, circle rhyming words, draw the picture, answer questions, etc.). I print the black and white poem pages 2 to a sheet and students glue these in a composition notebook. They are so excited to take their "Poem Book" home at the end of the year.




