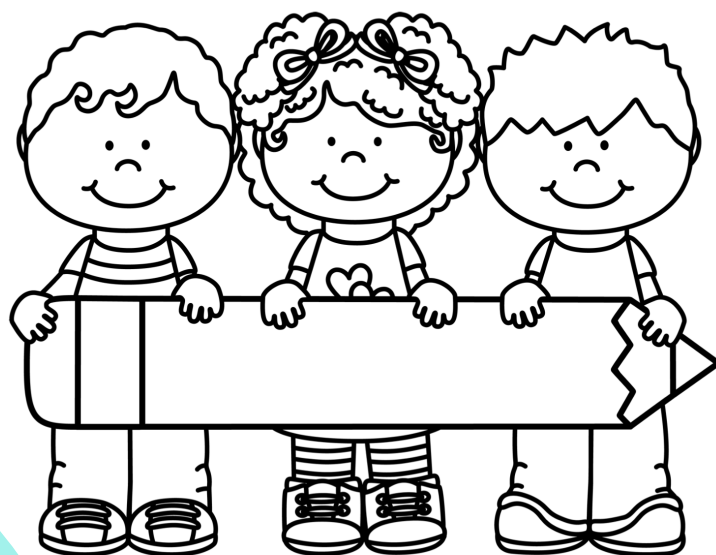
Students read three times for fluency. They color a picture each time they read.

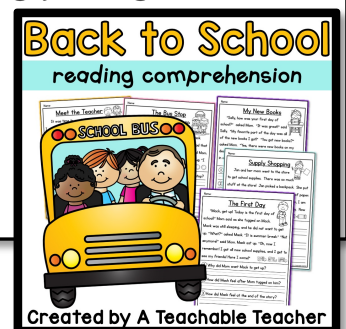

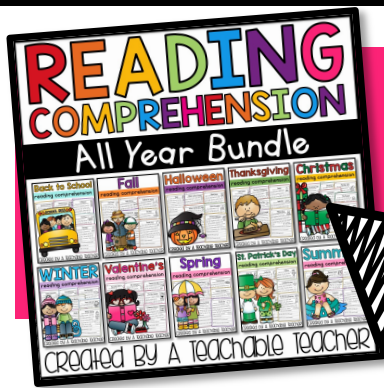

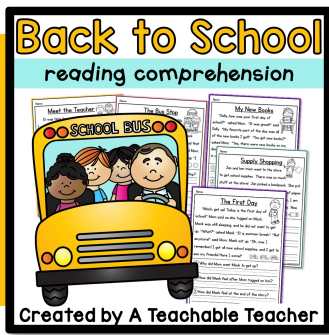
