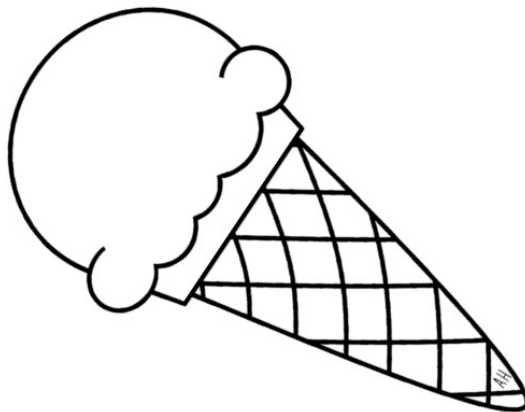

Easy-to-Follow Teacher Directions

The teacher directions include how to print, copy, & assemble.

How to Assemble Student Books & Readers

The top and bottom of each page are the same so that books can be printed back to back. However, you can choose not to print back to back if you prefer.

Once assembled, books can be stapled once or twice on the left side.

There is no line down the middle of the page. Pages are set up so you can cut them in half (5.5 inches on a paper cutter). That way, all pages are the same size and books are even once assembled.

Books and readers only have page numbers if the book requires sequential order. Otherwise, pages are left unnumbered so that books can be tailored to your student needs. Pages that are too easy or too hard can be left out.
