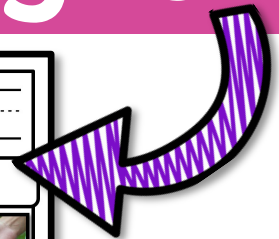

Vocabulary fresh liquid drizzle sleet solid

Precipitation is fresh water that falls to the ground. It comes from the clouds. The clouds are made up of water. They are made when the water in the air comes together. When the clouds drop water, it is called precipitation. Liquid precipitation is called rain. Smaller raindrops are called drizzle. Sleet is a cold, hard rain. It is liquid, too. Some precipitation is solid. Hail and snow are frozen precipitation. Hail is hard ice that falls from clouds. Snow is softer, but it is still solid. All types of precipitation are made of water.
