

## A phoneme segmentation game



Words with 3 \& 4 sounds

## EXAMPLE three sounds



For the word bag, students should point to:
$l^{\text {st }}$ dot: $/ \mathrm{b} /$ sound
$2^{\text {nd }}$ dot: $/ \mathrm{a} /$ sound
$3^{\text {rd }}$ dot: $/ \mathrm{g} /$ sound

Optional: Students can slide finger across the dots and blend the word back together.

## EXAMPLE four sounds



For the word frog, students should point to:
${ }^{\text {st }}$ dot:/f/sound
$2^{\text {nd }}$ dot: /r/ sound $3^{\text {rd }}$ dot: $/ 0 /$ sound $4^{\text {th }}$ dot: /g/ sound

Optional: Students can slide finger across the dots and blend the word back together.
