CHOCOLATE COVERED SOUNDS

## EXAMPLE three sounds



For the word fin, students should point to:
$\mathrm{l}^{\text {st }}$ dot: /f/ sound
$2^{\text {nd }}$ dot: $/ \mathrm{i} /$ sound
$3^{\text {rd }}$ dot: $/ \mathrm{n} /$ sound

Optional: Students can slide finger across the dots and blend the word back together.

The purpose of this activity is to provide practice segmenting words with three and four phonemes.

## EXAMPLE four sounds



For the word jump, students should point to: ${ }^{\text {st }}$ dot: /j/ sound $2^{\text {nd }}$ dot: /u/sound $3^{\text {rd }}$ dot: $/ \mathrm{m} /$ sound $4^{\text {th }}$ dot: $/ \mathrm{p} /$ sound

Optional: Students can slide finger across the dots and blend the word back together.
